IMPORTANT INFORMATION ABOUT ALL CAMPS
Team rates and prorated fees are available. Team rates are \$10 Off the fee listed for each individual per session (except for Kicking Camp, Passing Camp and Lineman Camp). Ten (10) or more participants from the same team attending the same camp session from beginning to end will qualify for this discount. LES MILES, HEAD COACH

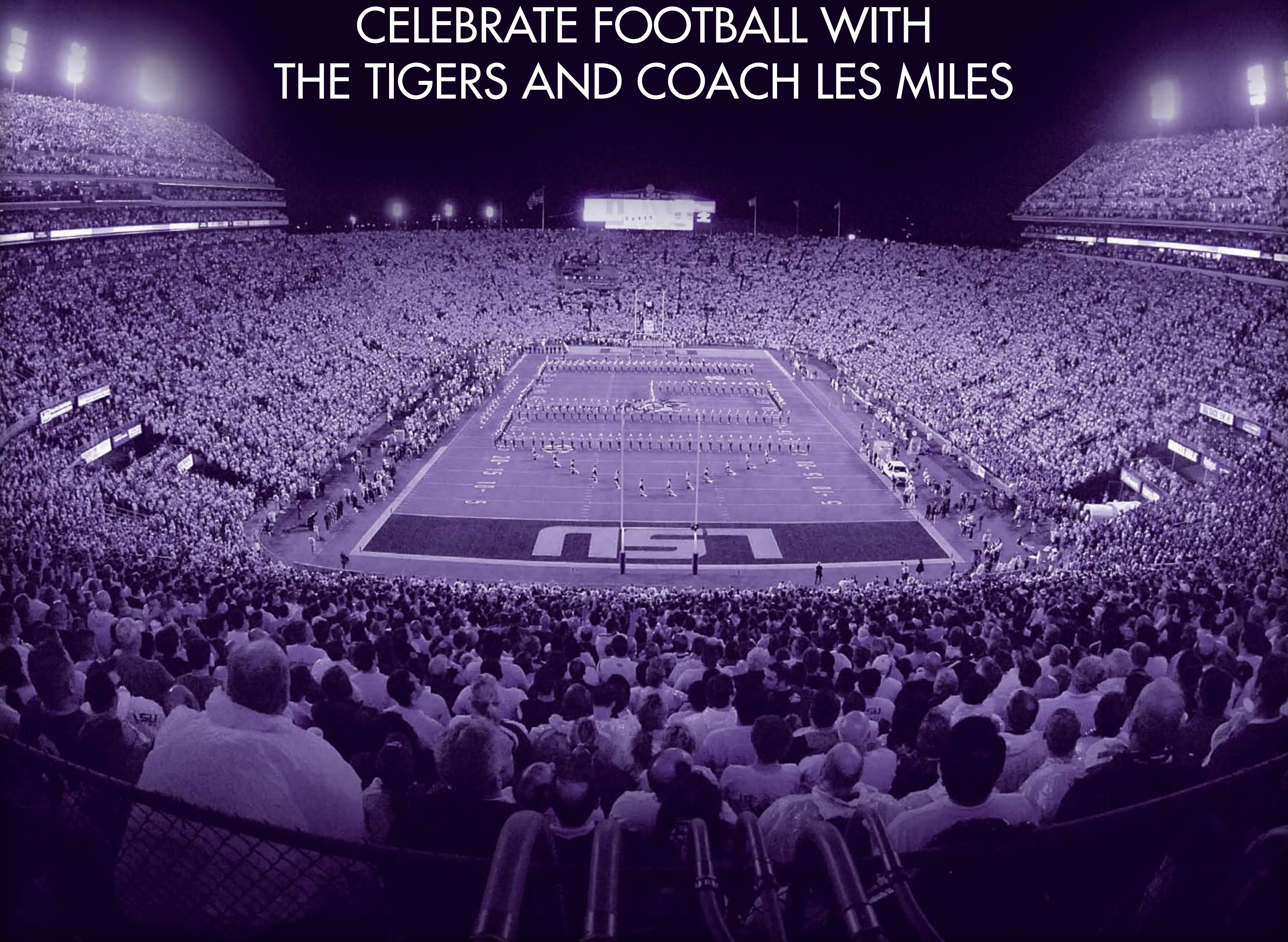
In his 6 years at LSU, Coach Miles has led what has been the best run in the history of football at the school.
