Post-Game Notes

Game 3: #3 UNO def. #4 Texas Southern, 18-5

UNO Notes

- * The win improves the Privateers record this season to 43-20.
- * UNO moves on to face the loser of Saturday night's game between top-seed LSU and No. 2 seed Southern Miss on Sunday at 1 p.m.
- * Sophomore right hander **Jim McGonigle** (2-2) notched the victory after pitching seven innings with two strike outs. His seven innings pitched ties a career high, which was set in a March 1 win over Vermont. The victory was also his first since March 1.
- * Sophomore center fielder **Ryan Eden** stole second base in the bottom of the first inning for his 19th stolen base of the season.
- * Sophomore third baseman **Nick Schwaner** stole second base in the bottom of the first inning for his 14th stolen base of the season.
- * Freshman right fielder **Jay Morris** stole third in the bottom of the second inning for his third stolen base of the season.
- * Junior second baseman **Johnny Giavotella** homered in the bottom of the third inning for his 12th home run of the season.
- * Senior catcher **Josh Vander Hey** stole second base in the bottom of the third inning for his fourth stolen base of the season.
- * Sophomore first baseman **Alan Harris** stole second base in the bottom of the third inning for his fifth stolen base of the season.
- * Junior catcher **Jeff Lanning** hit a grand slam in the bottom of the eighth inning for his 14th home run of the year.
- * The win marks the second straight season UNO has won a NCAA Tournament game (defeated No. 1 seed Wichita State in the NCAA Wichita Regional last year). The Privateers have not gone 0-2 in an NCAA Regional in its last five postseason appearances (last time was 1988 Central Regional in Austin, Texas).
- * UNO's 16 hits were the most since May 9 at Arkansas-Little Rock (a span of 13 games). It is the most runs scored since a 26-3 win at Arkansas State on April 27.
- * UNO's runs tally ties for the second-highest by the Privateers in an NCAA Regional game. The most was 24 against Jackson State in a 24-9 win in the 2000 NCAA South II Regional in Baton Rouge.
- * UNO's two home runs today extends the single-season school record to 96.

Texas Southern Notes

- * The season-ending loss puts the Tigers record at 16-34.
- * Senior right hander **Rashad Ford** (3-6) was credited with the loss after four innings pitched while relinquishing seven runs on five hits.
