THE SERIES

- LSU leads the all-time series, 2-1, with all three meetings coming in Baton Rouge: Tigers 56-17 (1977), Tigers 14-13 (1934), Ducks 12-0 (1932).
- UO is 4-5 all-time against schools from the Southeastern Conference, but has won three of the past four meetings vs. the SEC. Oregon was 1-1 vs. SEC teams last season, defeating Tennessee (48-13) in Knoxville and losing vs. Auburn (22-19) on a last-second field goal in the BCS National Championship Game.

QUICK HITS

- The Ducks are 16-4 in season openers since 1991 and 1-1 under head coach Chip Kelly.
- The Cowboys Classic marks the first time Oregon has ever played at a neutral site to start the
- While not technically a neutral site game, UO opened the season away from home against an opponent not playing at its regular home stadium when they faced the University of Houston at Reliant Stadium in 2005. Oregon prevailed, 38-24, in a battle of current NFL quarterbacks, UO's Kellen Clemens (Redskins) and UH's Kevin Kolb (Cardinals).
- Oregon's No. 3 preseason ranking by the AP and USA Today (coaches' poll) is the highest in program history.
- Oregon CB/PR Cliff Harris, a 2010 consensus All-America, will not play vs. LSU due to suspen-
- RB LaMichael James needs just 19 rushing yards to equal Derek Loville's (1986-89) school record of 3,296.

HEAD COACH CHIP KELLY

Oregon's 30th head coach, who in 2009 became the first in Pac-10 history to win an outright conference title in his first season at the helm, followed that feat with a second conference crown while securing the program's first trip to the BCS Championship Game following the 2010 season. The Manchester, N.H., native guided his team to more wins (22) in his first two years in the Pac-8/10/12 than any coach in conference history. Recognized as Pac-10 coach of the year for the second time in as many seasons, Kelly was named the recipient of five national coach of the year awards last year: AFCA, AP, Eddie Robinson, Sporting News and Walter Camp. He's overseen the team's first 12-win season and led the Ducks to a school-record 12-game winning streak. In his first head coaching job at any level, Kelly has a mark of 22-4, 17-1 in Pac-10 play. His .846 overall winning percentage is the highest in school history and his .944 percentage in conference play is the best in Pac-12 history.

RETURN MEN

The 2011 Oregon Ducks return 39 letterwinners, including 13 starters - seven on offense and six on defense. UO also welcomes back every specialist with the exception of holder **Nate Costa**.

DUCKS AND TIGERS IN COWBOYS CLASSIC

The No. 3 Ducks kick off the 2011 regular season by taking on the No. 4 LSU Tigers in the third annual Cowboys Classic Sept. 3 at Cowboys Stadium in Arlington, Texas. College football's marquee non-conference matchup to open the season pits a pair of preseason top-five teams against each other, marking just the third time that's ever happened on a neutral field to open the season and first since 1984.

VS. THE TOP 10

Oregon is 3-2 against the top 10 under **Chip Kelly**, with both defeats coming in BCS bowl games: vs. No. 8 Ohio State in the 2010 Rose Bowl and No. 1 Auburn in the 2011 BCS Championship.

VS. THE TOP 25

The Ducks went 3-1 against top 25 teams last season and are 7-3 against ranked opposition in the **Chip Kelly** era. UO's only loss to a nonranked team during Kelly's tenure came at Stanford on Nov. 7, 2009. The Cardinal became

ranked the following week as a result of their victory.

STUCK IN NEUTRAL

The Ducks have dropped their past two games at neutral venues, falling in the BCS title game in Glendale, Ariz., last January and in the Rose Bowl in January 2010. UO's last win on neutral ground came Dec. 30, 2008, over Oklahoma State in the Holiday Bowl.

THE GREATEST SHOW ON TURF

Oregon will presumably welcome the chance to play on the fake grass at Cowboys Stadium since the Ducks have run off 16 straight victories when playing on artificial turf. That streak stretches to 20, when said turf is colored green. UO's last loss on turf was Sept. 3, 2009, on Boise State's blue field. The last defeat on green turf was Nov. 1, 2008, at Cal.

NON-CONFERENCE SUCCESS

Oregon is 26-4 over its last 30 regular season, out-of-conference contests, earning notable victories against the likes of Oklahoma, Wisconsin and Michigan (x2). The Ducks are 3-0 against SEC teams during that stretch with wins over Mississippi State in 2002 (home) and '03 (away), and at Tennessee last season. Since Sept. 25, 2004, the Ducks are 17-2 in nonconference play during the regular season with both losses coming against Boise State home in 2008, away in 2009.

UO'S FIRST UNANIMOUS ALL-AMERICA

JR RB **LaMichael James** became Oregon's first unanimous All-America last season after being selected to the first team of all five teams formally recognized by the NCAA - AFCA, AP, FWAA, Sporting News and Walter Camp Football Foundation. James was one of 10 players to earn the unanimous distinction the only skill player on offense other than Oklahoma State wideout **Justin Blackmon**. UO's only consensus All-America players prior to 2010 were halfback **Mel Renfro** in 1961 and defensive tackle **Haloti Ngata** in 2005.

DOAK WALKER AWARD GOES TO JAMES

JR RB **LaMichael James** won the Doak Walker Award as the nation's top running back in 2010, more than meeting the award's criteria of making extraordinary contributions to his team while exhibiting characteristics of sportsmanship and fair play associated with the former SMU All-America and 1948

HARRIS NAMED CONSENSUS ALL-AMERICA

JR CB **Cliff Harris** was named a consensus All-America as a punt returner/all-purpose player in 2010 after being named first team All-America as a returner by the FWAA and Sporting News, and second team as a cornerback by the AP. He was just the fourth consensus pick all-time at UO and the first to earn All-America accolades as a specialist

SCORING MARKS FALL

The 2010 Oregon Ducks set a new school standard for scoring by putting up 611 points and led the nation at 47.0 per game. The previous mark was 545 set in 2008. Additionally, UO set a new Pac-10 record with 403 points in conference play, breaking USC's mark of 383 in 2005.

DUCKS SET RUSHING RECORD

With 3,721 rushing yards last season, Oregon bettered the previous school standard of 3,641 set in 2008. Leading the way was JR RB **LaMichael James**, who set the single-season rushing record with 1,731 yards. The Ducks also set a new single-game record, rolling up 528 yards in the win over Portland State to crush the previous mark - 465 yards at Washington in 2007 - by 63 yards.

KING JAMES

JR RB **LaMichael James** scored at least one touchdown in 11 of his 12 appearances last season and has 38 scores in 25 career games (35 rush, 3 rec). His 21 rushing TDs on the year broke **LeGarrette Blount's** former record of 17 in 2008, and his 35 career scoring totes are second all-time behind **Derek Loville's** 41 from 1986-89. James scored 144 points in his sophomore campaign, good for first on the UO single-season record list. On the Oregon career scoring list, the back ranks third with 228 points.

DOUBLE-DIGIT VICTORIES

Oregon recorded its third straight and sixth overall season of double-digit wins last season - all since 2000. The Ducks set a new record for victories in a season at 12, as well as wins over two-year (22), three-year (32), four-year (41) and five-year (48) spans.

TURNOVER CENTRAL

Oregon ranked second among FBS schools with 37 takeaways last season (21 INT, 16 FR), setting a new school record in the process.

AUTZEN ADVANTAGE

The Ducks have won 16 straight games at Autzen Stadium, dating to 2008, which is the second longest streak in stadium history. UO won a record 23 straight between 1997 and 2001. Oregon has won its last 13 Pac-10 contests at home since falling in overtime against Oregon State in the 2007 Civil War.

HOUSE OF LOUD

With six sold out crowds in as many games last season, including a State of Oregon record 60,017 vs. Washington on Nov. 6, Oregon has sold out Autzen Stadium (cap. 54,000) for 74 consecutive games, dating to 1999.

KELLY AT AUTZEN

Head coach **Chip Kelly** made his sideline debut at Autzen Stadium Sept. 12, 2009 (W 38-36 vs. Purdue) after spending the prior two seasons calling plays from a booth high above the field as the team's offensive coordinator. Since Kelly's arrival in 2007, the Ducks are 23-3 at Autzen, averaging 45.2 points per home game.

BACK TO BACK CHAMPS

With another Pac-10 crown in 2010, Oregon became the first team to win consecutive outright conference championships since USC won three in a row from 2003 to '05. Last year's team became the first to go undefeated in Pac-10 play since the start of round robin play in 2006 and the first to ever win nine league games. Four of UO's nine conference titles have come since the start of the 21st century.

COACHING CONTINUITY

An often overlooked facet of Oregon's success has been the continuity of its coaching staff. Third-year head coach Chip Kelly, now in his fifth season on staff, is a relative newcomer in Eugene compared to his core group of assistants, who have remained intact over the course of three different head coaches. Running backs coach Gary Campbell is in his 29th year on the Oregon staff, which equals the longest tenure of any Oregon assistant football coach in school history. In addition, offensive line coach and running game coordinator Steve Greatwood enters his 25th season at UO, linebackers coach Don Pellum is in his 22nd campaign, while defensive coordinator Nick Aliotti has spent 19 full seasons at Oregon over three separate stints. Of the dozen schools in the Pac-12, only Oregon and Washington saw no turnover on their respective staffs from 2010 to '11.
