LSU, #8 Penn State Square Off For NCAA Sweet 16 Berth At 8:45 p.m. Tuesday

No. 6 seed LSU (21-11) seeks its first Sweet 16 berth since 2008 as the Lady Tigers face No. 3 seed Penn State (26-5) in a rematch of last year's NCAA Tournament second round matchup at 8:45 p.m. CT Tuesday in the Maravich Center on ESPN2. The winner advances to face the winner of No. 10 seed South Florida-No. 2 seed California on Saturday in Spokane, Wash.

- The Lady Tigers are making their 22nd all-time NCAA Tournament appearance and they own a 40-20 all-time NCAA record.
- LSU claimed its 40th all-time NCAA win with a 75-71 first round victory over 20th-ranked Green Bay on Sunday night. The Lady Tigers snapped the Phoenix 24-game win streak and handed Green Bay its first loss since Dec. 5.
- LSU has reached at least the second round of the NCAA Tournament in each of its last 15 appearances.
- LSU is seeking its 13th Sweet 16 appearance and its first since 2008. LSU is 7-3 in NCAA Second Round games in Baton Rouge
- Penn State leads the series with LSU, 4-2, and the two are ironically meeting agai since the Lions ended LSU's last season in the second round here in Baton Rouge by a score of 90-80 on March 20, 2012. Penn State has won the last two meetings.
- The Lady Tigers are 15-3 all-time in NCAA Tournament games played in Baton Rouge. LSU is hosting for the eighth time.
- **Nikki Caldwell** is a combined 49-11 in the NCAA Tournament with three NCAA titles as a player, graduate assistant, assistant coach and head coach. Caldwell is 4-3 as a head coach in the tournament (2-2 at UCLA, 2-1 at LSU). She is seeking her first Sweet 16 berth as a head coach in her fifth overall year.
- LSU went on a seven-game win streak late in the season with wins over three top-15 teams -- Georgia, Kentucky and Texas A&M -- to solidify its NCAA at-large status. LSU is 14-3 at home this season, including four straight home wins.
- Jr. F **Theresa Plaisance**, a first-team All-SEC selection, is the SEC's second-leading scorer with 17.3 ppg. Plaisance has scored in double-figures in every game except the season-opener. She ranks 19th nationally in blocks per game with an SEC-best 2.6. She has 83 blocks on the season, which ranks fifth in LSU single-season history. Plaisance's 31 consecutive double-figure scoring games is the longest stretch by an LSU player since Seimone Augustus did it in 97 straight (2003-06).
- Fr. G Danielle Ballard is an SEC All-Freshman selection and five-time SEC Freshman of the Week. She ranks second among all SEC freshmen in scoring (12.3 ppg) and rebounding (6.6 rpg). She leads all SEC players in steals with 95, which is second nationally among all freshmen. With her two steals in the win over Green Bay, Ballard shattered the LSU overall single-season record of 93 set by Marie Ferdinand in 1999-2000. She also had 16 points and a career-best six assists in her first NCAA game.
- LSU owns a 5-5 record against teams in the Top 25 and the Lady Tigers are 3-2 against ranked teams at home.
- The Lady Tigers are 7-5 vs. the Big Ten since 2003 but have lost five straight to Big 10 opponents dating back to 2010.

Nikki Caldwell

HEAD COACH • SECOND SEASON AT LSU, FIFTH SEASON OVERALL

Nikki Caldwell, who won national championships as both a player and an assistant coach at Tennessee and turned UCLA into a national power in just three years, has quickly brought LSU women's basketball back to national prominence.

Caldwell revived the LSU program from her opening press conference. A summer full of speaking engagements, building the fan base and connecting with her players led to a season where attendance increased by an average of over 1,500 fans from the previous season. LSU also signed a top-20 recruiting class as ranked by ESPN HoopGurlz. com.

After missing the NCAA Tournament for the first time in 13 years a season prior to her arrival, Caldwell spearheaded the squad to the 2012 NCAA Tournament second round and its first appearance in the Southeastern Conference Tournament championship game since 2008. The Lady Tigers reached 23 wins – their highest total since the 2008 Final Four season – won 10 conference games for the first time since 2009 and claimed wins over five ranked teams during the season.

Well respected in coaching circles, Caldwell was then selected by the USA Women's Basketball Committee to serve as an assistant coach for the USA U18 National Team in the summer of 2012. She became the first coach in LSU history to serve on a USA U18 team staff since the squad's inception in 1988. Caldwell and the Americans celebrated on the international stage as the USA U18 team cruised to a 5-0 record and beat Brazil to win the 2012 FIBA Americas Championship gold medal in Puerto Rico.

Caldwell has been a part of a championship and winning pedigree at every level of her career. She played, coached and studied under one of the game's greatest figures, the legendary Pat Summitt at Tennessee and she assisted Women's Basketball Hall of Famer Debbie Ryan at Virginia.

Widely recognized as one of the nation's top assistant coaches during stints at Tennessee and Virginia, Caldwell took over at UCLA in 2008. In three years with the Bruins, she turned around a UCLA program that had won only one NCAA Tournament game in the nine years prior to her arrival.

Caldwell led the Bruins to a 72-26 (.735) overall mark, reached the NCAA Tournament twice and finished second in the Pac-10 Conference in both 2010 and 2011. She was named the Pac-10 Coach of the Year in 2010 after going 25-9 overall and advancing to the second round of the NCAA Tournament.

Caldwell broke into the head coaching ranks after serving as an assistant on the staff of legendary women's coach Pat Summitt at Tennessee from 2002-08. During that time, she helped the Lady Vols capture a pair of NCAA titles in 2007 and 2008 and reach the Final Four a total of five times. The Lady Vols compiled an impressive 195-24 mark and won three Southeastern Conference regular season titles during her six years as an assistant coach.

Off the court, Caldwell is a passionate crusader for breast cancer awareness. She and Tennessee head coach Holly Warlick have founded the non-profit organization, Champions for a Cause. Since 2007, they have raised over \$300,000 through Cruisin' for a Cause, a long-haul motorcycle adventure to raise dollars and awareness for a cure for breast cancer. Caldwell has been prominent in the Baton Rouge community since her arrival, making appearances at the Baton Rouge Food Bank and schools in the East Baton Rouge Parish system.

NOTEBOOK

More Storylines

- Senior guard **Adrienne Webb**, a second-team All-SEC selection by the league's coaches, ranks seventh in the SEC in scoring (14.2 ppg) and has the most experience of any player on the LSU roster. Webb has played in four career in NCAA Tournament games and she has played in 127 career games with 90 starts. With her start against Green Bay, she moved into a tie for 10th place in LSU career games played. When she takes the floor against Penn State, she will move into ninth place tying Erica White (2004-08) with 128 games played.
- Adrienne Webb fired in 15 points and four threes for the second straight game in the win over Green Bay in the first round. Webb has scored in double-figures in five consecutive games and she is LSU's leading scorer in the last five contests, averaging 16.2 ppg in those contests. In her last three games, she is a combined 9-of-18 (50.0 percent) from three-point range. Since being held scoreless on Jan. 10 at Arkansas, Webb has scored in double-figures in 14 of 16 contests.
- Junior forward **Shanece McKinney** has had a tremendous impact defensively since entering the starting lineup on Feb. 4 against Texas A&M. McKinney has blocked a combined 18 shots in LSU's last eight games, including two thunderous ones in the NCAA first round win over Green Bay. McKinney played a career-high 33 minutes against the Phoenix, scoring seven points to go along with six rebounds and two steals.
- Junior guard **Jeanne Kenney** dished out six assists in the Green Bay win before colliding with Adrienne Webb on an inbounds play with 0:44 left in the game. She was carried off the floor and did not return after injuring her head. She is questionable for Tuesday's game. Kenney has missed only one game this season, suffering a shoulder injury at Arkansas which forced her to miss the Mississippi State game on Jan. 13. She sprained her left knee in the Texas A&M game on Feb. 4 but played the following game. She also suffered a stress reaction in her foot which nearly forced her to miss the Kentucky game on Feb. 24.
- LSU established the motto "Eight is Enough" late in the season, referring to the diminished eight-player roster the Lady Tigers hold. Despite a roster of eight, winning has been no problem for LSU as the Lady Tigers have posted a 6-1 record since the roster went to that on Feb. 21 at Missouri.
- With the win against Green Bay, LSU upped its home record to 14-3 on the season. In two seasons under Nikki Caldwell, LSU is 27-7 in the Maravich Center.
- LSU buried a season-best 9-of-14 threes on Sunday against Green Bay, including multiple
 makes from Adrienne Webb (four), Theresa Plaisance (2-of-2) and Bianca Lutley (2-of2). The Lady Tigers' previous high for threes this season was seven against Georgia in the
 SEC Tournament. LSU has combined for 16 threes in its last two games.
- Sophomore forward **Sheila Boykin** will miss the remainder of the season after being diagnosed with Guillain-Barre syndrome, a disorder that affects the nervous system. Boykin was feeling numbness in her feet against Mississippi State on Feb. 17. Two days later, she was diagnosed with the syndrome. She is expected to fully recover. The Missouri game on Feb. 22 was LSU's first game without Boykin. She played in 25 games, averaging 11.7 minutes, 1.4 points and 2.3 rebounds per game.
- **Nikki Caldwell** has won 80.9 percent of her games (521-123) as a player, graduate assistant, assistant coach and head coach dating back to her freshman season of 1990-91 at Tennessee. Caldwell was on the 1991 Tennessee Final Four team as a player that won the national title in New Orleans, site of this year's Final Four.

A Look Back at Last Year's NCAA Meeting: LSU vs. Penn State

No. 4-seed Penn State used an 8-3 in the closing minutes to advance past No. 5 seed LSU, 90-80, in the NCAA Second Round at the Pete Maravich Assembly Center. Trailing 76-73 with 2:17 remaining, LSU guard **Bianca Lutley** pulled down a defensive rebound but had the ball stripped away by Penn State's Zhaque Gray who make a layup. LSU wouldn't get any closer. Penn State's Maggie Lucas scored a game-high 30 points on 7-of-12 shooting including five three pointers and 11-of-11 free throws. She had 19 points in the first half. Ariel Edwards had 15 and Mia Nickson added 14, as the Nittany Lions shot 44.6 percent from the field (29 of 65) and 86.2 percent from the free throw line (25 of 29). Lutley also had her first career double-double with 14 points and 10 rebounds with four assists. Theresa Plainsance made two three pointers and had 10 points, and guard Adrienne Webb had 11 points. LSU shot 37 percent from the field (27 of 73) and committed 12 of its 18 turnovers in the second half. Making 22-of-24 free throws kept LSU on or close to the lead until the final two minutes of the game. The Lady Tigers took a 37-36 lead into the lockerroom though each team was under 40 percent shooting. LSU pushed the lead to five, 47-42, as LaSondra Barrett scored four straight in the opening minutes of the second half. Plaisance's second three pointer gave LSU its biggest lead, 50-44 with 15:22 remaining, but the Nittany Lions bounced back with six-straight to tie the game.

Had the first 20-point performance of her career at Georgetown on Nov. 19, scoring 20 points to go along with seven rebounds and a career-high five steals in 34 minutes ... Named FIU Classic MVP after leading LSU past the Panthers with 20 points, six rebounds and seven blocks on Nov. 25 ...
