## No. 1 LSU Heads to Vegas to Face No. 23 NC State in Lady Luck Invite

Coming off a big 196.950-196.725 season-opening win against Oklahoma, LSU jumped to a tie for No. 1 in the national rankings, and the Tigers will put that ranking to the test on the road. LSU will compete against No. 23 North Carolina State in the Lady Luck Invitational at 9 p.m. CT Thursday in Las Vegas, Nev. The meet will be streamed live by FloGymnastics and will be available to subscribers. It's a short week for both squads as the Wolfpack also competed on Saturday and came away with a big 194.700-194.125 win at Penn State. Myia Hambrick led the way with a 39.450 to win her first career all-around title, and she also added career-high 9.90s on beam and floor to pace the Tigers. Ashleigh Gnat was not far behind as she managed a 39.425 in the all-around, and she won the floor title (9.95) and vault title (9.90). Randii Wyrick shared the vault title, her first, with a 9.90, and freshman Sarah Finnegan captured the beam title with a 9.925 in her first collegiate meet. LSU posted a 49.250 on vault to rank first nationally, 49.250 on beam to rank second, 49.475 on floor to rank second and a 48.975 on bars to rank 12th. LSU's 196.950 ranked as the third-highest season opening score in program history, and the victory marked LSU's fifth vs. a No. 1 team in Baton Rouge since 1997. The Tigers are now 5-3-1 vs. a No. 1 team in a home meet since 1997. Now, it's LSU that is No. 1 for the seventh time in school history and the first since 2014. The Tigers hope to improve to 2-0 on the season against a solid NC State team.

### STORYLINES

- LSU has gone undefeated at home in back-to-back seasons for the first time since 1982-84. The Tigers are 17-0 in the Maravich Center since the start of the 2014 season. During that stretch, LSU has beaten No. 7 Alabama, No. 14 Auburn, No. 2 Florida, No. 9 Georgia, No. 16 Minnesota and No. 1 Oklahoma.

record. The two teams last met on March 7, 2014 in Baton Rouge, a 197.500-195.525 LSU win.

- LSU has earned the No. 1 ranking for the seventh time in program history and the first time since the 2014 season.
- LSU returns to the Lady Luck Invitational for the second time in school history. The Tigers competed here on Jan. 15, 2010 and placed

third out of four teams with a 195.350. Missouri finished first (195.625), Kentucky was second (195.525) and Arizona State was fourth (192.675).

- LSU received huge contributions from freshman Sarah Finnegan who posted a 9.925 on beam, the highest score in an LSU gymnast's first career beam routine in program history.

# D-D Breaux

HEAD COACH • 39TH SEASON

With each passing season, LSU gymnastics continues to collect more honors and titles to its storied program, and head coach D-D Breaux has been the catalyst behind LSU's sustained success.

Led by Breaux, LSU has seen increasing accolades that include nine NCAA Championships appearances in the last 10 seasons, four Super Sixes since 2008 and nine individual national titles since 2002.

In 2015, Breaux guided LSU to a 13-1 overall regular season record, which included a perfect 7-0 record against SEC competition for the first time in school history.

The list of achievements in 2014 includes a program-record third-place national finish in the NCAA Super Six Finals, another individual national title by Rheagan Courville on vault, the 13th regional title in school history, the highest score in program history on three different occasions, 20 total All-America honors including a nation-leading five First-Team All-Americans, and a school-record 13 consecutive meets with at least a 197 score.

Because of her outstanding efforts in leading LSU to a record season, Breaux was not only named the 2014 Central Region Coach of the Year, but she was also honored as 2014 National Coach of the Year.

In 2013, LSU recorded the 12th regional team title in school history, and the Tigers reached the NCAA Super Six for the third time in 2013, recording a fifth-place finish. Three gymnasts won five individual SEC titles in Courville (VT, BB, AA), Lloimincia Hall (FX) and Jessica Savona (FX).

In 2010 LSU reached the NCAA Championships for the ninth straight year while senior Susan Jackson became the first LSU gymnast to capture the NCAA All-Around national

title, and she also won the 2010 balance beam title to become LSU's first three-time NCAA champion.

In 2008 LSU joined elite company by advancing to the NCAA Super Six Finals as Breaux and the Tigers broke through into the six-team field for the first time in program history to compete for college gymnastics' national championship. The Tigers placed fifth.

In 2009, LSU made a repeat trip to the Super Six to compete for the national title, and one day later Breaux and staff coached senior Ashleigh Clare-Kearney to two individual national titles on vault and floor.

As the "Dean of Coaches" at LSU, Breaux has represented the University at the highest level both in the gym and in the classroom for more than 30 years.

Entering her 39th season as the mastermind of the LSU gymnastics program, the fire in Breaux's eyes burns as brightly today as it did on her first day on the job.

During her tenure Breaux has established and maintained LSU's reputation as one of the premier collegiate gymnastics programs in the country. Under her tutelage, the Tigers have placed among the nation's top-10 teams 26 times in 38 seasons, finishing a program-best third in 2014, fourth in 1988 and fifth in 2008 and 2013.

LSU has also placed among the top three in regional competition on 30 separate occasions, winning regional titles 14 times in four different decades, including back-to-back first-place regional finishes in 2008 and 2009 and 2013-2015. Under her leadership, LSU has captured 10 individual national titles, 167 All-America honors and 59 All-SEC selections.

## NOTEBOOK

### Last Time Out

- In front of a season-opening record home crowd of 8,228 fans, the fifth-ranked LSU gymnastics team fought from behind to take down No. 1 Oklahoma, 196.950-196.725, in the Maravich Center.
- LSU (1-0) outscored Oklahoma (0-1) 49.475-49.200 in the fourth and final rotation to complete the comeback victory and send the Maravich Center crowd into a frenzy.
- Individually, Myia Hambrick captured her first career all-around title with a 39.450. Ashleigh Gnat and Randii Wyrick tied for the vault title with a 9.90, Sarah Finnegan won the beam crown with a 9.925, and Gnat tallied her second career floor title with a 9.95. Oklahoma's McKenzie Wofford won the bars title with a 9.95.

### LSU Back at the Lady Luck Invite for Second Time; First Trip was 2010

- LSU is making its second appearance at the Lady Luck Invitational. The Tigers first appeared at the meet on Jan. 15, 2010 when the 16th-ranked Tigers finished third of four teams. LSU scored a 195.350 to finish behind No. 15 Missouri (195.625) and No. 14 Kentucky (195.525). LSU beat Arizona State which finished with a 192.675.
- LSU experienced great individual success at the Lady Luck where Susan Jackson won the all-around (39.625), vault (9.95), beam (9.90) and floor (9.85) titles. LSU's Summer Hubbard won bars with a 9.95.

### Hambrick, Finnegan and Zamardi Complete Near-Sweep of SEC Weekly Awards

- LSU sophomore Myia Hambrick was named SEC Co-Gymnast of the Week, Shae Zamardi earned SEC Specialist of the Week and Sarah Finnegan was crowned SEC Freshman of the Week after the Tigers took down then-No. 1 Oklahoma in the season opener.
- Hambrick captured her first career all-around title with a 39.450, and she tied or set career highs on beam and floor with a 9.90 on each event. She also posted a 9.875 on vault that helped LSU finish with a nation-leading 49.250 in the event.
- Finnegan delivered in a big way in her first collegiate meet to help the Tigers defeat the Sooners. She tallied an outstanding 9.925 on beam to claim the event title and lead the Tigers to a 49.250 in the event. Finnegan's 9.925 is the highest score in an LSU gymnast's first career beam routine in school history.
- Zamardi provided clutch performances on bars and floor in the opener. She posted a 9.925 in her first career floor routine to help clinch LSU's victory. In fact, Zamardi had not even performed an exhibition floor routine since her freshman season, and when the Tigers needed her most she produced a fantastic performance in the fourth spot in the lineup. Zamardi's 9.925 is the highest score in an LSU gymnast's first career floor routine since teammate Jessica Savona tallied a 9.925 in her first floor performance on Jan. 4, 2013 vs. North Carolina State. She also posted a team-high tying 9.85 in the anchor spot on bars to place second in the event.

- Sophomore Nicole Wild of NC State ranks No. 4 nationally on beam with a 9.900 score in the opener.

## LSU in the Rankings

- LSU is ranked No. 1 in the latest Road To Nationals standings. LSU also ranks No. 1 nationally on vault after scoring a 49.250 against the Sooners. The Tigers are No. 2 nationally on floor with a 49.475, No. 3 on beam with a 49.250 and No. 17 on bars with a 48.975.
- Individual Rankings: Sarah Finnegan: 3rd BB, 22nd UB; Ashleigh Gnat: 2nd FX, 5th AA, 5th VT, 9th BB; Myia Hambrick: 4th AA, 4th BB, 10th FX, 13th VT; Randii Wyrick: 5th VT, 23rd FX; Shae Zamardi: 6th FX, 22nd UB.
- This is the 19th straight year that LSU has been ranked in the top 15 in the preseason poll and the fourth straight in the Top 10.

## LSU is No. 1 for the Seventh Time in School History

- LSU is tied with Michigan for the No. 1 national ranking this week with a 196.950 season average. It is the seventh time in school history LSU has earned the nation's top ranking.
- Here are the other times LSU was ranked No. 1: Feb. 21, 2005, March 14, 2005, April 21, 2005, Feb. 24, 2014, March 3, 2014, March 10, 2014 and this week Jan. 11, 2016.

## LSU Extended Unbeaten Streak in the Maravich Center

- LSU has gone unbeaten at home in the last two seasons as the Tigers went 11-0 in 2014 and 5-0 in 2015. The Tigers are 1-0 this season after beating then-No. 1 Oklahoma on Jan. 9.
- LSU won all seven home meets in 2014: Centenary, No. 14 Auburn, No. 7 Alabama, Missouri, No. 25 North Carolina State, Kentucky and the NCAA Baton Rouge Regional (No. 10 Stanford, No. 13 Auburn, No. 21 Arizona, Iowa State, Kent State).
- LSU won all five home meets in 2015: Iowa, Missouri, No. 9 Georgia, No. 2 Florida, No. 16 Minnesota.

- With LSU ranked No. 5 and Oklahoma No. 1, the season opener marked the first time in LSU history that the Tigers opened a season with a Top 5 matchup.
- The last time LSU opened the season in a Top 10 matchup was Jan. 2, 2009 when No. 7 LSU won the Cancun Classic against No. 8 Michigan, No. 19 Boise State and North Carolina.

## Ashleigh "Bugs" Gnat - One of the Nation's Top All-Arounders

- LSU's Ashleigh Gnat enters her junior season as one of the top all-arounders in the country, following a breakout sophomore season in 2015.
- Bugs currently ranks No. 5 nationally in the all-around, trailing teammate Myia Hambrick (who is 4th) by .025 in the standings.
- Last season Gnat ranked 13th nationally in the all-around and posted the nation's fourth-highest all-around total with a 39.725 vs. Minnesota on March 6, 2015.
- Gnat also finished No. 10 nationally in the floor rankings with a 9.930 regional qualifying score (RQS), and she also ranked 19th nationally on beam.
