LSU to Face Stiff Test on the Road at No. 11 Georgia

Fifth-ranked LSU heads back on the road this week to take on No. 11 Georgia at 3 p.m. CT Saturday in Stegeman Coliseum. The Tigers are hoping to carry momentum into the meet after scoring a season-high 197.425 last week in a home win against No. 8 Arkansas. Saturday's contest will be carried live on SEC Network+ and available to watch online. Against the Razorbacks, LSU sophomore Myia Hambrick led the squad with arguably her finest meet as a Tiger. Hambrick won at least a share of all five individual titles and tied or set career highs on bars (9.925), beam (9.925), floor (9.90) and the all-around (39.625). Ashleigh Gnat, Sydney Ewing and Randii Wyrick tied Hambrick for the vault title as all four Tigers scored a 9.875. Sarah Finnegan tied Hambrick for the beam crown with a 9.925, and Gnat and Wyrick tied Hambrick for the floor title with 9.90s. As a team LSU set a season high with a 49.450 on beam, the team's highest beam score since March 6, 2015 when the Tigers posted a 49.475 against Minnesota. LSU will be in for a big challenge against the GymDogs who just sprung the upset against previously No. 1 Florida, 196.400-196.350. Leading the charge for LSU will Hambrick who ranks No. 4 nationally in the all-around, 20th on vault, 23rd on bars and 25th on floor. Gnat ranks 1st on vault, 6th on floor and 16th in the all-around. Erin Macadaeg is still No. 1 on floor, and Sydney Ewing, Julianna Cannamela, Lexie Priessman, Randii Wyrick and Shae Zamardi are all ranked in at least one event as well.

STORYLINES

- LSU has gone undefeated at home in back-to-back seasons for the first time since 1982-84. The Tigers are 19-0 in the Maravich Center since the start of the 2014 season. During that stretch, LSU has beaten No. 7 Alabama, No. 14 Auburn, No. 2 Florida, No. 9 Georgia, No. 16 Minnesota and No. 1 Oklahoma.
- LSU is 3-21 all-time against Georgia in Athens. The Tigers are searching for their first win against Georgia in Athens since the SEC Championship in 1990. The last time LSU beat Georgia in Athens in a dual meet was the 1983 season opener.
- LSU has eight gymnasts ranked in the Top 25 in at least one event, one of the top totals in the nation.
- LSU is looking to ride the momentum from last week's season-high 197.425, the Tigers' first 197 score of the year.
- LSU is also hoping to extend its SEC regular season win streak. The Tigers went 7-0 last season and are 3-0 so far this year.
- LSU junior Ashleigh Gnat is the only gymnast in the nation to score two perfect 10.0s this season. Gnat earned hers on vault in back-to-back weeks against Kentucky and at the Metroplex Challenge. She ranks No. 1 nationally on vault.

D-D Breaux

HEAD COACH • 39TH SEASON

With each passing season, LSU gymnastics continues to collect more honors and titles to its storied program, and head coach D-D Breaux has been the catalyst behind LSU's sustained success.

Led by Breaux, LSU has seen increasing accolades that include nine NCAA Championships appearances in the last 10 seasons, four Super Sixes since 2008 and nine individual national titles since 2002.

In 2015, Breaux guided LSU to a 13-1 overall regular season record, which included a perfect 7-0 record against SEC competition for the first time in school history.

The list of achievements in 2014 includes a program-record third-place national finish in the NCAA Super Six Finals, another individual national title by Rheagan Courville on vault, the 13th regional title in school history, the highest score in program history on three different occasions, 20 total All-America honors including a nation-leading five First-Team All-Americans, and a school-record 13 consecutive meets with at least a 197 score.

Because of her outstanding efforts in leading LSU to a record season, Breaux was not only named the 2014 Central Region Coach of the Year, but she was also honored as 2014 National Coach of the Year.

In 2013, LSU recorded the 12th regional team title in school history, and the Tigers reached the NCAA Super Six for the third time in 2013, recording a fifth-place finish. Three gymnasts won five individual SEC titles in Courville (VT, BB, AA), Lloimincia Hall (FX) and Jessica Savona (FX).

In 2010 LSU reached the NCAA Championships for the ninth straight year while senior Susan Jackson became the first LSU gymnast to capture the NCAA All-Around national

title, and she also won the 2010 balance beam title to become LSU's first three-time NCAA champion.

In 2008 LSU joined elite company by advancing to the NCAA Super Six Finals as Breaux and the Tigers broke through into the six-team field for the first time in program history to compete for college gymnastics' national championship. The Tigers placed fifth.

In 2009, LSU made a repeat trip to the Super Six to compete for the national title, and one day later Breaux and staff coached senior Ashleigh Clare-Kearney to two individual national titles on vault and floor.

As the "Dean of Coaches" at LSU, Breaux has represented the University at the highest level both in the gym and in the classroom for more than 30 years.

Entering her 39th season as the mastermind of the LSU gymnastics program, the fire in Breaux's eyes burns as brightly today as it did on her first day on the job.

During her tenure Breaux has established and maintained LSU's reputation as one of the premier collegiate gymnastics programs in the country. Under her tutelage, the Tigers have placed among the nation's top-10 teams 26 times in 38 seasons, finishing a program-best third in 2014, fourth in 1988 and fifth in 2008 and 2013.

LSU has also placed among the top three in regional competition on 30 separate occasions, winning regional titles 14 times in four different decades, including back-to-back first-place regional finishes in 2008 and 2009 and 2013-2015. Under her leadership, LSU has captured 10 individual national titles, 167 All-America honors and 59 All-SEC selections.

Last Time Out

- LSU recorded a season-high 197.425 to beat No. 8 Arkansas' 196.150.
- LSU (7-1, 3-0 SEC) posted a 49.300 on vault, 49.275 on bars, 49.450 on beam and 49.400 on floor.
- Myia Hambrick won at least a share of all five titles. Ashleigh Gnat shared the vault and floor titles as did Randii Wyrick. Sydney Ewing also tied for the vault title, and Sarah Finnegan tied for the beam title.

OH MY-ia Hambrick!

- LSU sophomore Myia Hambrick has been very consistent as an all-arounder this season as she ranks No. 4 nationally in the category with a 39.450 season average.
- Hambrick is coming off arguably her finest meet as a Tiger. She won at least a share of all five individual titles against Arkansas, and she tied or set career highs on bars (9.925), beam (9.925), floor (9.90) and the all-around (39.625).
- She is the first LSU gymnast to win all five titles in a meet since Rheagan Courville did it last season against Georgia.
- Hambrick has earned SEC Gymnast of the Week twice (after meets against Oklahoma and Arkansas).

Ashleigh Gnat: Back-to-Back Perfect 10.0s

- LSU junior Ashleigh Gnat earned the first perfect 10.0 of her career with a fantastic stuck double-twisting Yurchenko vault against Kentucky on Jan. 22, and she followed it up with another 10 on vault at Metroplex on Jan. 30.
- Gnat is the eighth gymnast in LSU history to score a 10 on vault, but only the fifth to earn multiple 10s on vault. LSU now has 46 perfect 10s in history including 23 on vault.
- Gnat is the first gymnast in LSU history to earn a perfect 10 on a DTY vault.

LSU Continues Undefeated SEC Regular Season Streak; Now at 10

- For the first time in school history last season LSU finished with a perfect regular season record against Southeastern Conference competition as the Tigers went 7-0, and the Tigers continued the winning ways against Arkansas on Feb. 5.
- LSU is currently 10-0 after wins this season over Kentucky, Missouri and Arkansas, and the Tigers will look to extend that streak this week at Georgia.

Sarah Finnegan and Lexie Priessman Making Great Early Impressions

- LSU freshman Sarah Finnegan has wasted no time making her presence known as she has scored a 9.950 on bars and 9.925 on beam in the first two meets of the season and added a 9.90 in her first career floor routine at Metroplex.
- Finnegan's 9.95 was the highest score of any freshman in the nation, tied with Michigan's Olivia Karas who earned a 9.95 on floor. Finnegan is the first gymnast in school history to post a 9.95 on bars in the first road meet of her career.
- Her 9.925 vs. OU in the opener is the highest score in an LSU gymnast's first career beam routine in school history.
- LSU freshman Lexie Priessman has also made an immediate impact, posting a 9.925 in her first career bars routine against Kentucky. Her 9.925 tied the school record for the highest score in a gymnast's first official bars routine. Katherine Hilton tallied a 9.925 in her first bars routine vs. Denver on Jan. 31, 2003.

- This season marked the 19th straight year that LSU has been ranked in the top 15 in the preseason poll and the fourth straight in the Top 10.

Ashleigh Gnat is the Third LSU Gymnast to Earn Back-to-Back Perfect 10s on the Same Event

- LSU junior Ashleigh Gnat recorded 10s on vault against Kentucky (Jan. 22) and at the Metroplex Challenge (Jan. 30) to become the third LSU gymnast to tally back-to-back 10s on the same event.
- Gnat joins Jennifer Wood and Lloimincia Hall in accomplishing the feat. Wood scored 10s on vault on Feb. 18, 1994 and Feb. 25, 1994. Wood also earned 10s on vault on Feb. 17 and Feb. 24, 1995. Hall tallied 10s on floor on March 6 and March 13, 2015.

Hambrick, Finnegan and Zamardi Complete Near-Sweep of SEC Weekly Awards in Week 1

- LSU sophomore Myia Hambrick was named SEC Co-Gymnast of the Week, Shae Zamardi earned SEC Specialist of the Week and Sarah Finnegan was crowned SEC Freshman of the Week after the Tigers took down then-No. 1 Oklahoma in the season opener.
- Hambrick captured her first career all-around title with a 39.450, and she tied or set career highs on beam and floor with a 9.90 on each event. She also posted a 9.875 on vault that helped LSU finish with a 49.250 in the event.
- Finnegan delivered in a big way in her first collegiate meet to help the Tigers defeat the Sooners. She tallied an outstanding 9.925 on beam to claim the event title and lead the Tigers to a 49.250 in the event. Finnegan's 9.925 is the highest score in an LSU gymnast's first career beam routine in school history.
- Zamardi provided clutch performances on bars and floor in the opener. She posted a 9.925 in her first career floor routine to help clinch LSU's victory. In fact, Zamardi had not even performed an exhibition floor routine since her freshman season, and when the Tigers needed her most she produced a fantastic performance in the fourth spot in the lineup. Zamardi's 9.925 is the highest score in an LSU gymnast's first career floor routine since teammate Jessica Savona tallied a 9.925 in her first floor performance on Jan. 4, 2013 vs. North Carolina State. She also posted a team-high tying 9.85 in the anchor spot on bars to place second in the event.

LSU Extended Unbeaten Streak in the Maravich Center

- LSU has gone unbeaten at home in the last two seasons as the Tigers went 11-0 in 2014 and 5-0 in 2015. The Tigers are 3-0 this season after beating then-No. 1 Oklahoma on Jan. 9, No. 20 Kentucky on Jan. 22 and No. 8 Arkansas on Feb. 5.
- LSU won all seven home meets in 2014: Centenary, No. 14 Auburn, No. 7 Alabama, Missouri, No. 25 North Carolina State, Kentucky and the NCAA Baton Rouge Regional (No. 10 Stanford, No. 13 Auburn, No. 21 Arizona, Iowa State, Kent State).
- LSU won all five home meets in 2015: Iowa, Missouri, No. 9 Georgia, No. 2 Florida, No. 16 Minnesota.
- The Tigers will look to extend that unbeaten streak against Auburn on Feb. 19.
- Overall since 1997, LSU is 5-3-1 in Baton Rouge against the No. 1 ranked team after beating OU on Jan. 9.

LSU Earns No. 1 for the Seventh Time in School History

- LSU was tied with Michigan for the No. 1 national ranking in the Jan. 11 rankings with a 196.950 season average. It marked the seventh time in school history LSU has earned the nation's top ranking.
- Here are the other times LSU was ranked No. 1: Feb. 21, 2005, March 14, 2005, April 21, 2005, Feb. 24, 2014, March 3, 2014, March 10, 2014 and Jan. 11, 2016.

Tigers Take Down No. 1 Oklahoma at Home

- In front of a season-opening record home crowd of 8,228 fans, the fifth-ranked LSU gymnastics team fought from behind to take down No. 1 Oklahoma, 196.950-196.725, in the Maravich Center.
- LSU (1-0) outscored Oklahoma (0-1) 49.475-49.200 in the fourth and final rotation to complete the comeback victory and send the Maravich Center crowd into a frenzy.
- Individually, Myia Hambrick captured her first career all-around title with a 39.450. Ashleigh Gnat and Randii Wyrick tied for the vault title with a 9.90, Sarah Finnegan won the beam crown with a 9.925, and Gnat tallied her second career floor title with a 9.95. Oklahoma's McKenzie Wofford won the bars title with a 9.95.

Season Opener Was a Matchup of “Epic Proportions”

- With LSU ranked No. 5 and Oklahoma No. 1, the season opener marked the first time in LSU history that the Tigers opened a season with a Top 5 matchup.
- The last time LSU opened the season in a Top 10 matchup was Jan. 2, 2009 when No. 7 LSU won the Cancun Classic against No. 8 Michigan, No. 19 Boise State and North Carolina.

Ashleigh “Bugs” Gnat and Myia Hambrick - Two of the Nation’s Top All-Arounders

- LSU’s Ashleigh Gnat enters her junior season as one of the top all-arounders in the country, following a breakout sophomore season in 2015. Sophomore Myia Hambrick has emerged early this season as an outstanding all-arounder in her own right.
- Bugs currently ranks No. 16 nationally in the all-around, trailing Hambrick who is 4th.
- Last season Gnat ranked 13th nationally in the all-around and posted the nation’s fourth-highest all-around total with a 39.725 vs. Minnesota on March 6, 2015.
- Gnat also finished No. 10 nationally in the floor rankings with a 9.930 regional qualifying score (RQS), and she also ranked 19th nationally on beam.

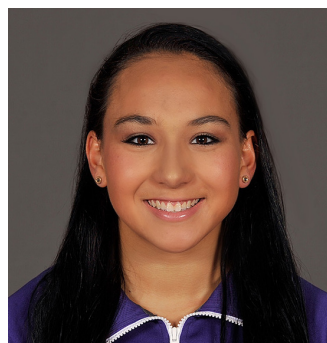
