FIRST PITCH

- LSU opens the 2017 season at home hosting the Tiger Classic
- The Tigers are opening the season at home for the seventh consecutive year.
- LSU is 16-4 in season openers dating back to 1997.
- The team has won each of the last two and three of the last four overall.
- In home openers dating back to 1997, LSU is 18-2.
- The Tigers have won eight of their last 10 home openers.
- Last year LSU defeated Ohio State 9-0 in five innings in Baton Rouge.
- LSU returns 15 total letterwinners from last year's team.
- Of those 15 returners, five were everyday positional starters

and three are starting pitchers.

- LSU has won no less than 30 home games in each of the last two seasons.
- The 10-game home stand to start the season will be the longest stretch of home contests for the Tigers this season.
- LSU is 38-8 all-time against McNeese State, Oklahoma State and Penn State.
- This is the 32nd meeting against McNeese, with the two teams playing again April 11 in Lake Charles
- This is the first meeting against OSU and PSU since the 2014 season.

A Look Back - 2016 Season

- LSU finished the year with a 52-18 overall record and 13-11 record in the SEC.
- The Tigers finished the year ranked No. 3 by the NFCA and No. 4 by USA Softball, the second consecutive season finishing in the top five.
- The team qualified for the Women's College World Series for the second consecutive season, the first time in program history doing so.
- It was also the second consecutive year that the team finished the season in the national semifinals.
- Although LSU finished seventh in the SEC standings in the regular season, the Tigers made it all the way to the SEC Tournament finals for the first time since 2010.
- To get there, LSU came back to defeat Texas A&M in the opener and earned a pair of heart-stopping 3-1 wins over Kentucky and Tennessee to advance to the title game.
- LSU was stout at home over the course of the season, sporting a 31-9 record at Tiger Park
- On the road the Tigers were 12-5, with a 9-4 record in neutral site contests.
- The team finished the season hitting .316 as a group, the third consecutive year the squad has batted above .300 as a group.
- LSU's 577 total hits as a team last year are the most for the group during that three year stretch, while being the fourth most in a single year in program history.
- The Tiger pitching staff finished the year with a staff ERA of 1.89, the second-straight season the pitchers have had a sub-2.00 ERA for a season.
- After not earning double figure shutouts in 2014, the Tiger pitchers have combined for 37 in each of the last two seasons combined.
- Savannah Jaquish and Bianka Bell were named NFCA All-Americans at the end of the year, while Bell and Jaquish were named All-SEC.
- Bell led the team in hitting with a .381 average and 14 home runs, while Jaquish led the team with 19 doubles and was second with 13 home runs.
- Bailey Landry led the team in triples with six.
- Carley Hoover led the pitching staff with 22 wins and 225 total strikeouts.
- Sydney Smith led the staff with a 1.16 ERA and seven shutouts, including throwing a perfect game.
- Allie Walljasper led the team in saves with three, and also belted a game-tying home run against Georgia and walk-off home run in the season finale against Washington.
