1st Year at LSU • 5th Year as a Head Coach

Frank William "Will" Wade was named the 22nd head men's basketball coach at LSU on March 20, 2017. He comes to LSU after a two-year stint as the head coach at Virginia Commonwealth University with four years of very successful experience as a head basketball coach.

Wade was introduced to LSU fans in a most unique way for an introduction of a Tiger coach -- at a special media event held in the middle of the LSU Student Union. Wade told the media and a large contingent of LSU students:

"I am so excited about the opportunity to lead this program and LSU Basketball back to the top of the SEC and back to regular, consistent NCAA Tournament appearances. We have been to four Final Fours. We have been to 21 NCAA Tournaments. We have 10 SEC Championships, and we are going to add to all three of those categories over our tenure here.

"We are going to have players, staff members, everyone in our program is going to be committed to doing what it takes to make LSU the best basketball program that it can be. We are going to have unwavering commitment to put the team first, to put the state first, to put our school first to represent all of these folks in a first-class fashion. We are going to be a hardworking team that represents this great university that represents this great state," Wade said.

LSU and its fans are not looking for a rebuilding program, but taking the foundation and making it solid again -- a change of culture that gives the program a look of consistency year-after-year.

Wade, one of the youngest coaches in Division I at 34, but one of the most energetic showed his recruiting chops early with a class for the 2017-18 season that was ranked 16th in college basketball in the composite recruiting rankings.

Wade's recruiting chops and promotional ideas has created a buzz in the pre-season that hasn't been seen too often and the Coach has done his part, speaking most of the summer on the Tiger Tour and to student groups making sure they feel a part of the program. Coach Wade has been seen on the night prior to football game visiting with folks in the RV lots and on the first day of school was out in a golf cart picking up students and giving them a lift to opening day classes.

The native of Nashville, Tennessee, directed VCU to a 51-20 record and two NCAA Tournament appearances the last two seasons. The 2016 Rams advanced to the second round of the tournament, defeating seventh-seed Oregon State before losing to Oklahoma. Wade was the youngest head coach in the NCAA Tournament in 2016. In 2017, VCU lost to St. Mary's in the first round of the 2017 tourney.

The Rams were 28-8 over his two years in the Atlantic 10 Conference, posting 14-4 records both

years. The team was 25-11 in 2016 and earned a share of the Atlantic 10 Conference regular season crown. The 2017 team won 26 games and finished second in the league, one-game behind Dayton.

Under his tutelage, guard Melvin Johnson earned First Team All-Atlantic 10 honors in 2015-16 while Je Quan Lewis represented VCU on the 2016-17 first team. Mo Alie-Cox was named to the A-10 Defensive Team in both 2016 and 2017.

Wade, age 34, previously served at VCU as an assistant with the Rams under Shaka Smart from 2009-13. VCU was 113-37 during that time, reached three NCAA Tournament and won the 2012 Colonial Athletic Association Championship. He was part of the staff in 2011 when VCU advanced from the NCAA "First Four" all the way to the Final Four in Houston.

During his tenure as a Ram assistant, Wade, who worked closely with VCU's post players, saw the Milwaukee Bucks select center Larry Sanders with the 15th overall pick in the 2010 NBA Draft (now with Cleveland). In addition, Wade played a major role in the development of current NBA players Troy Daniels (Memphis) and Briante Weber (Charlotte). Weber owns VCU records for 3-pointers in a single season and career steals.

Wade is credited with being a key figure in four top non-power five recruiting classes in his four seasons at VCU.

Prior to becoming the head coach at VCU, Wade served as the head coach at Chattanooga for the 2013-14 and 2014-15 seasons.

His first Mocs squad went 18-15 in 2014, finishing 12-6 and second in regular season Southern Conference play. The 18 wins overall were the most by the program since 2008-09 and the 12 wins in league games was the highest total since 2010-11. The team made the school's first postseason appearance since 2009 in the CIT.

Wade was honored with the Anton Foy Southern Conference Coach of the Year award for his efforts in 2014. Also that year, Z. Mason became the first Chattanooga student-athlete to win the conference's Defensive Player of the Year award.

The Mocs won 22 games in 2015 and finished 15-3 in the league as Wade guided Chattanooga to its first 20-win season since 2004-05. He finished his two seasons there at 40-25 and 27-7 in league play. In the two seasons prior to his arrival, Chattanooga was 24-40 overall and 13-23 in SoCon play.

In his four years as a head coach, he has a combined record at Chattanooga

and VCU of 91-45 and 55-15 in conference play with three post-season appearances.

Wade's reputation, where ever he has coached, is a person who is a tireless worker and relentless recruiter. Wade was VCU Head Coach Shaka Smart's first hire upon being named the head VCU coach in 2009.

That reputation was cemented prior to his arrival on the VCU campus. He served as an assistant to Tommy Amaker at Harvard in 2007-08 and 2008-09. Much like at VCU, he was Amaker's first hire. In their second year, the Crimson went 14-14, the first season of .500 or better in the program since 2001-02. Wade had a hand in the development of future NBA standout Jeremy Lin and assembled a top 25 recruiting class during his stay.

Wade's coaching start came at Clemson where he served as Director of Basketball Operations (2006-07) and Graduate Assistant (2005-06) after four seasons as a student manager (2002-05). There he worked for coaches Larry Shyatt (2002-03) and Oliver Purnell (2004-07).

In eight years on coaching staffs at Clemson, Harvard and VCU, the teams had a record of 177-97 with six postseason appearances (2005-13).

Wade is married to the former Lauren Deason, and the couple has one daughter, Caroline Elizabeth.

3-6 -- LSU record in Maui Jim Maui Invitational (3 previous appearances, '92, '96, '07)

LAST TIME OUT – LSU 105, SAMFORD 86 (Nov. 16, Baton Rouge)

So the Tigers scored 100 points since December 2015 and LSU starts 2-0 in the Will Wade era and one would assume all is good, right?

Well, not exactly. Things were not at a happy level in Coach Wade's postgame after his Tigers gave up 58 second half points in the 105-86 win over Samford on Thursday at the Maravich Center.

Now LSU had the offense as the Tigers scored 58 points as well in the second half to keep the 47-28 advantage in tact that it built in the first half. But Samford hit 11-of-18 trey attempts in the opening 20 minutes and 15-of-29 for the game.

LSU would hit 39-of-65 from the field (60.0%) and 19-of-20 from the free throw line to keep Samford at bay.

Five players would score in double figures for LSU with junior Brandon Sampson and Skylar Mays both scoring 20 points. Sampson was 8-of-13 from the field and had seven assists in the game. Mays had four treys in the win. Wayde Sims had 13 points, Duop Reath 12 and Brandon Rachal had 10.

Tremont Waters, the SEC Freshman of the Week, was not in the starting lineup because of missing practice time during the week after being banged up in the Alcorn game, but came

off the bench to play 27 minutes. He had eight assists and one turnover.

Waters' replacement in the lineup, Daryl Edwards, had eight points, six assists and no turnovers.

THE TIGERS DID WHAT AT THE LINE????

An LSU team that at times struggles at the line over the years, was on the mark against Samford (11/16), making 19-of-20 for the game, including 16-of-16 in the first half. LSU's lone miss came in the first half with 2:38 to play after LSU made its first three of the night. It marked the fourth time since 1966-67 for LSU to shoot at least 95% when attempting at least 20 FT's in a game:

- 11/16/2017 – W, vs. Samford – 105-86; 19-of-20 FTs (95.0%)**
- 2/21/2009 – W, vs. Auburn – 79-72; 21-of-22 FTs (95.5%)**
- 2/2/2008 – L, at Alabama – 72-81; 21-of-22 FTs (95.5%)**
- 2/4/1989 – L, at Miss. State – 79-96; 19-of-20 FTs (95.0%)**

OFFENSIVE SCORING

In two games, LSU is scoring at 102 points a game after scoring 99 against Alcorn State and 105 against Samford ... One has to go back to 1994-95 to find a year when LSU scored big to open the season – 106 against Southeastern and 86 against McNeese. Ironically that year, LSU would follow with 127 against George Mason and 113 against Troy.

OUR WEBMASTER HAD TIME TO STUDY THIS

Todd Politz, with time to spare, figured out that LSU shooting over 60 percent in both games was the 15th and 16th times this century (since the start of 2000-01 year) that LSU has shot over 60 percent in contest.

RETURNING PLAYERS DOING GOOD IN WILL WADE SYSTEM

Coach Wade has discussed with the media how his returnees he inherited have worked hard and improved in his system since taking over at LSU. In the first two games, the numbers seem to back some of that up.

- Brandon Sampson – 10 and 20 pts in the 2 games, 13 rebounds, 7 asts – 15.0 ppg**
- Skylar Mays – 20 pts vs. Samford, 7 asts in the two games – 13.5 ppg**
- Wayde Sims – 24 pts combined in the two games – 12.0 ppg**
- Duop Reath – 23 pts combined in the two games 11.5 ppg**

As mentioned early, senior Aaron Epps was limited in the Samford game after missing the Alcorn game but he is expected to be closer to full go for the Michigan game. Coach Wade pointed out how good his 10 minutes were as he was 4-of-5 from the floor.

LSU AND ITS MAUI HISTORY

The Tigers are 3-6 in its three Maui appearances with 1-2 records all three years ... 1992 was the one time when LSU won its opening game, 72-63, before losing to Duke and Memphis. That tourney marked the coming out party for senior center Geert Hammink, who after being beaten on for three years in practice by Shaquille O'Neal, impressed NBA scouts and earned All-Tournament honors. He would go on to average a double-double, make first team All-SEC and earn from Shaq's Orlando team, a first round selection in the 1993 NBA draft.

LSU in 1996, got its win in the middle game against Iowa, while in 2007 a middle game win came against Chaminade.

In 1992, when LSU played in Maui, the tournament was played on Dec. 21-23 in Lahaina at the iconic Civic Center.

THE OPPONENT IN THE OPENER – MICHIGAN

The Wolverines are 3-0 after a 61-47 win over Southern Mississippi on Thursday night. M-A Abdur Rahkman had 14 points, Moritz Wagner and Duncan Robinson 12 each to lead Michigan. The Wolverines shot 48.9% and was 8-of-23 from the arc.

John Beilein is in his 40th season as a head coach, his 11th as the head coach at Michigan.

The Tigers and Michigan will be meeting for the third time but the first time since a back-to-back set of games in December of 1995 and 1996. LSU lost at the Maravich Center, 69-68, in 1995 and then fell to Michigan, 70-59, in a 1996 game at the Palace of Auburn Hills.

TREMONT WATERS' OPENING GAME EARNS SEC FRESHMAN OF THE WEEK HONORS

Tremont Waters' strong performance against Alcorn (11/10) earned him the vote of the Southeastern Conference office as SEC Freshman of the Week.

It marked the second straight year that an LSU player has been honored on the first week of the season. Then junior Duop Reath in the opening win over Wofford earned SEC Player of the Week honors after his opening game of the 2016-17 season.

Waters had the first 4x5 game by an LSU player since Ben Simmons had a 4x5 in the win over North Florida in Dec. 2015.

Waters was 9-of-13 from the field, which included 4-of-6 from distance and 5-of-6 from the arc. It was the second best scoring game on the opening two days of play in the league.

RETURNING POINTS, REBOUNDS, ASSISTS

As seen in the first two games, returnees have done well for LSU so far this season ... The Tigers returned 45.0 of its 74.8 points per game average from last season (60.2%) and 20.1 rebounds of a 36.1 rebounds per game (55.7%) ... Duop Reath is the returning scorer and rebounder at 12.0 points per game and 6.2 rebounds a game. Brandon Sampson averaged 11.6 points per game.

However, LSU averaged 74.8 points per game, but opponents last year scored at one of the highest opponents scoring averages in years (7th highest all-time), 83.0 ppg. It was the highest since opponents averaged 89.4 points in the 1988-89 season.

LSU has averaged over 70 points on offense each of the last five seasons, the longest streak since the Tigers were over 70 points in 14 straight seasons starting in 1982-83 through the 1995-96 season.

LSU opponents last season made more three-pointers than any year of the three-point shot against the Tigers, 277 and made 38.3 of their attempts. That was 81 more than LSU made last year (196). In the opener, LSU made 11 treys and held Alcorn to just four, but Samford made 15 on Thursday.

REATH LOOKING FOR GOOD FINAL YEAR

Reath is the leading returnee in a lot of categories most notably in points (12.0) and rebounds (6.2). Reath was No. 13 in the league in rebounding average last year and third in field goal percentage (51.0%, 158-of-308) ... He was eighth in blocked shot average (1.5). He averaged 27.7 minutes a game and started every game except senior night a year ago ... Reath had seven double doubles a year ago.

SKYLAR MAYS A SECOND POINT GUARD

Coach Will Wade likes having two point guards on the court to handle the ball and run the offense through and Mays, who played the primary point guard a year ago, has certainly adapted well to being the second PG behind so far Waters and Edwards.

Mays has received good notice from Coach Wade, who averaged 8.3 points, 2.2

rebounds and a tenth in the league best of 3.6 assists a contest last year starting at point guard in 25-of-the-31-games ... Mays has had 14 games in double figures, 10 in SEC play and eight games of five assists or more ... As has been the norm with LSU point guards for the last 15 years, Mays had a positive assist-to-turnover number of 113 assists to 69 turnovers last year.

Mays is from Baton Rouge and Findlay Prep in Nevada after attending University High.

BRANDON SAMPSON

When the Tigers went to Australia for a foreign tour in August 2015 prior to the 2015-16 season, Sampson about to enter his freshman season, was one of the stars, especially from the FIBA three-point arc. The season didn't prove to be a success, averaging only 4.0 points per game and just 27 percent from the college arc.

Last year, he improved as a sophomore to averaging 11.6 points per game and 33.9 percent from the arc. So far in two games, Sampson has made 12-of-17 field goals, 3-of-7 from the arc to average 15 points and 3.5 assists. He also leads the team in rebounds at 6.5 a game. Seven of his 13 rebounds have been offensive.

TIGERS LOCAL CONNECTION

SIGNEE DAY DISCUSSION

LSU men's basketball coach Will Wade and his coaching staff made the most of their first fall signing period together as a staff putting together three outstanding signees that has LSU ranked fifth in the nation in the composite team recruiting rankings.

The Tigers signed two players in the top 32 in the country and three in the top 61, according to ESPNU (one five-star and two four-star athletes) and the 247sports.com composite team rankings has LSU ranked fifth in the country with the present signing class behind only Duke, Kentucky, North Carolina and Kansas.

According to its website, the 247Sports Composite is a proprietary algorithm that compiles rankings and ratings listed in the public domain by the major media recruiting services, creating the industry's most comprehensive and unbiased prospect and team rankings.

The Tigers signed five-star forward Naz Reid of Rochelle Catholic in New Jersey, ranked No. 18 by ESPNU and four-star athletes Ja'Vonte Smart of Scotlandville Magnet in Baton Rouge (ranked No. 32); and, Darius Days of IMG Academy in Florida (ranked No. 61).

"Our staff has worked extremely hard since we arrived to find the best prospects that fit what we were looking for at LSU," said Coach Wade. "I am grateful for their efforts. We are excited about getting these three players here next year and we appreciate their belief in what we are trying to accomplish here at LSU. We are continuing to work hard, even as the season begins, to find those players that fit in our system and have the same values that we do regarding LSU and this basketball program," Coach Wade continued. "This class is only complete for the time being. We are now recruiting for the spring signing period in 2018 and beyond."

DARIUS DAYS – Four-star forward Darius Days will attend the IMG Academy in Sarasota, Florida this coming season. NAZ REID – Five-star forward Nazreon Reid of Asbury Park, New Jersey is a 6-10 power forward. Reid prepped at Roselle (New Jersey) Catholic school. Reid was listed as the No. 3 power forward for the class of 2018. He played this past summer for Sports U and averaged 14.1 points, 9.9 rebounds and 2.0 blocks per game. For Roselle as a junior he averaged 13.8 points and 9.1 rebounds a contest. He helped lead Roselle Catholic under Coach Dave Boff to the Tournament of Champions title. According to SB Nation, Reid has a 7-5 wingspan and a vertical of 19.5" with a standing reach of nine feet.

JA'VONTE SMART – Four-star guard Ja'Vonte Smart of Scotlandville Magnet High School in Baton Rouge is the two time winner of the Louisiana Farm Bureau Insurance/Louisiana Sports Writers Association Mr. Basketball award as well as the Gatorade Louisiana Boys Basketball Player of the Year. He was MVP of the Louisiana Sports Writers Association Class 5A team for the second time as well. Smart is the No. 1 player in the state of Louisiana. As a junior, Smart led Scotlandville to the LHSAA Division I select state title with averages of 25.1 points, 8.7 rebounds, 6.4 assists and 2.1 steals. It was the second state title in three seasons for Scotlandville and Coach Carlos Sample.
