# Will Wade

**Head Coach**

1st Year at LSU • 5th Year as a Head Coach

Frank William "Will" Wade was named the 22nd head men's basketball coach at LSU on March 20, 2017. He comes to LSU after a two-year stint as the head coach at Virginia Commonwealth University with four years of very successful experience as a head basketball coach.

Wade was introduced to LSU fans in a most unique way for an introduction of a Tiger coach -- at a special media event held in the middle of the LSU Student Union. Wade told the media and a large contingent of LSU students:

"I am so excited about the opportunity to lead this program and LSU Basketball back to the top of the SEC and back to regular, consistent NCAA Tournament appearances. We have been to four Final Fours. We have been to 21 NCAA Tournaments. We have 10 SEC Championships, and we are going to add to all three of those categories over our tenure here.

"We are going to have players, staff members, everyone in our program is going to be committed to doing what it takes to make LSU the best basketball program that it can be. We are going to have unwavering commitment to put the team first, to put the state first, to put our school first to represent all of these folks in a first-class fashion. We are going to be a hardworking team that represents this great university that represents this great state," Wade said.

LSU and its fans are not looking for a rebuilding program, but taking the foundation and making it solid again -- a change of culture that gives the program a look of consistency year-after-year.

Wade, one of the youngest coaches in Division I at 34, but one of the most energetic showed his recruiting chops early with a class for the 2017-18 season that was ranked 16th in college basketball in the composite recruiting rankings.

Wade's recruiting chops and promotional ideas has created a buzz in the pre-season that hasn't been seen too often and the Coach has done his part, speaking most of the summer on the Tiger Tour and to student groups making sure they feel a part of the program. Coach Wade has been seen on the night prior to football game visiting with folks in the RV lots and on the first day of school was out in a golf cart picking up students and giving them a lift to opening day classes.

The native of Nashville, Tennessee, directed VCU to a 51-20 record and two NCAA Tournament appearances the last two seasons. The 2016 Rams advanced to the second round of the tournament, defeating seventh-seed Oregon State before losing to Oklahoma. Wade was the youngest head coach in the NCAA Tournament in 2016. In 2017, VCU lost to St. Mary's in the first round of the 2017 tourney.

The Rams were 28-8 over his two years in the Atlantic 10 Conference, posting 14-4 records both

years. The team was 25-11 in 2016 and earned a share of the Atlantic 10 Conference regular season crown. The 2017 team won 26 games and finished second in the league, one-game behind Dayton.

Under his tutelage, guard Melvin Johnson earned First Team All-Atlantic 10 honors in 2015-16 while Je Quan Lewis represented VCU on the 2016-17 first team. Mo Alie-Cox was named to the A-10 Defensive Team in both 2016 and 2017.

Wade, age 34, previously served at VCU as an assistant with the Rams under Shaka Smart from 2009-13. VCU was 113-37 during that time, reached three NCAA Tournament and won the 2012 Colonial Athletic Association Championship. He was part of the staff in 2011 when VCU advanced from the NCAA "First Four" all the way to the Final Four in Houston.

During his tenure as a Ram assistant, Wade, who worked closely with VCU's post players, saw the Milwaukee Bucks select center Larry Sanders with the 15th overall pick in the 2010 NBA Draft (now with Cleveland). In addition, Wade played a major role in the development of current NBA players Troy Daniels (Memphis) and Briante Weber (Charlotte). Weber owns VCU records for 3-pointers in a single season and career steals.

Wade is credited with being a key figure in four top non-power five recruiting classes in his four seasons at VCU.

Prior to becoming the head coach at VCU, Wade served as the head coach at Chattanooga for the 2013-14 and 2014-15 seasons.

His first Mocs squad went 18-15 in 2014, finishing 12-6 and second in regular season Southern Conference play. The 18 wins overall were the most by the program since 2008-09 and the 12 wins in league games was the highest total since 2010-11. The team made the school's first postseason appearance since 2009 in the CIT.

Wade was honored with the Anton Foy Southern Conference Coach of the Year award for his efforts in 2014. Also that year, Z. Mason became the first Chattanooga student-athlete to win the conference's Defensive Player of the Year award.

The Mocs won 22 games in 2015 and finished 15-3 in the league as Wade guided Chattanooga to its first 20-win season since 2004-05. He finished his two seasons there at 40-25 and 27-7 in league play. In the two seasons prior

to his arrival, Chattanooga was 24-40 overall and 13-23 in SoCon play.

In his four years as a head coach, he has a combined record at Chattanooga and VCU of 91-45 and

55-15 in conference play with three post-season appearances.

Wade's reputation, where ever he has coached, is a person who is a tireless worker and relentless recruiter. Wade was VCU Head Coach Shaka Smart's first hire upon being named the head VCU coach in 2009.

That reputation was cemented prior to his arrival on the VCU campus. He served as an assistant to Tommy Amaker at Harvard in 2007-08 and 2008-09. Much like at VCU, he was Amaker's first hire. In their second year, the Crimson went 14-14, the first season of .500 or better in the program since 2001-02. Wade had a hand in the development of future NBA standout Jeremy Lin and assembled a top 25 recruiting class during his stay.

Wade's coaching start came at Clemson where he served as Director of Basketball Operations (2006-07) and Graduate Assistant (2005-06) after four seasons as a student manager (2002-05). There he worked for coaches Larry Shyatt (2002-03) and Oliver Purnell (2004-07).

In eight years on coaching staffs at Clemson, Harvard and VCU, the teams had a record of 177-97 with six postseason appearances (2005-13).

Wade is married to the former Lauren Deason, and the couple has one daughter, Caroline Elizabeth.

### LAST TIME OUT -- LSU 75, ARKANSAS 54 -- FAYETTEVILLE -- Jan. 10, 2018

The LSU Tigers dominated the Arkansas Razorbacks to the tune of a 21-point victory in Bud Walton Arena Wednesday night, tying the second biggest margin of victory by LSU in the series history.

Arkansas led, 1-0, for 20 seconds in the first minute of the game before Aaron Epps hit a layup and then a three-pointer to put LSU up 5-1. The lead reached double figures at the 14:09 mark of the first period on a free throw by Duop Reath and LSU held a double digit lead the rest of the way, some 34-plus minutes.

The Tigers led by as much as 24 points with 4:47 to go in the opening half before going to the dressing room up 20, 41-21. LSU made 15-of-27 shots in the opening half compared to 6-of-33 (18.2%) for the Razorbacks. Included in that was 1-of-11 from the arc.

Arkansas did make its runs, cutting the game to 13 and finally 12, 55-43, with 10:42 to go, but LSU scored the next 11 points to push the lead back to 23, many of them on lay ups at the goal.

LSU had one of its most balanced nights scoring with four players in double figures led by Aaron Epps with his third double double of the year with 13 points and 11 rebounds. Skylar Mays and Randy Onwuasor had 12 each with Duop Reath adding 11. Tremont Waters scored eight, but also had eight assists in the game.

The Tigers shot 52.7 percent, the highest ever in Fayetteville, and held a 44-26 advantage in the paint and 15-6 in points off turnovers.

### OTHER GAME NOTES

The margin of victory (21) tied LSU's second biggest in the history of the Arkansas series. The biggest LSU win was 29 points in an 85-56 win on March 13, 2003 at the SEC Tournament in New Orleans at the Superdome.

The win was LSU's seventh all-time in Fayetteville (2018, 2015, 2009, 2006, 2004, 2002 and 2000) with the



previous largest margin 11 points in 2000 and 2004.

LSU improved to 78-0 since the 1966-67 season when leading by 20+ points at halftime.

#### WHAT A START ON THE ROAD

Although the Tigers didn't play a true road game until Dec. 29, LSU is 3-0 after win at Memphis (Dec.29), Texas A&M (Jan. 6) and Arkansas (Jan. 10). That's the first time LSU has won three straight road games since winning at Ole Miss, Florida and Vanderbilt in succession, Jan. 14-24, 2015.

The last time LSU won three road games in succession to open a year was the 1988-89 campaign under Dale Brown when LSU beat Florida in Gainesville, Chaminade in Honolulu and Maryland in College Park.

#### BACK AT HOME

Now the Tigers have to do something about their home record which stands at 7-2, with more importantly, just one game played in the SEC. The Tigers lost 74-71 to Kentucky in the first game for LSU of the conference season.

The Tigers now have two games at home back-to-back starting tonight against Alabama and Tuesday versus Georgia. After going 8-1 in the SEC at home in 2015-16, the Tigers were 1-8 at home a year ago.

In this, the 47th year of play at the Maravich Center, the Tigers are 248-148 or 62 percent.

#### A&M GAME STARTS WILL WADE ON NEXT HUNDRED

Just a couple of games after winning his 100th game as a college head coach on Dec. 29, the next 100 started with a bang on Tremont Waters' winning three at A&M (1/6).

Number 100 happened on the first try in the 71-61 win at Memphis.

The win occurred in his 148th career game as a Division I coach. Wade came to LSU after two years at Chattanooga (40) and two years at VCU (51) with 91 combined wins and his ninth win at Memphis made it 100.

#### A&M WIN, FIRST OF SEASON OVER NATIONALLY-RANKED TEAM

After losses to Notre Dame in Maui and then last week at home against Kentucky, the A&M game marked the first win against a nationally-ranked team this year. The Aggies were ranked No. 11 in the AP poll and the Tigers are now 6-10 all-time against teams ranked No. 11 ... The win was win No. 79 by LSU when unranked against a ranked team in the history of the AP poll (79-254, 23.7%).

#### WATERS EARNS SECOND SEC FRESHMAN OF THE WEEK HONOR

For Tremont Waters, the play at the end of the Texas A&M game certainly helped him earn his second SEC Freshman of the Week honor in a season that has already seen him three times get recognition on SportsCenter's Plays of the Day.

The 5-11, 167-pounder averaged 19.5 points, eight rebounds, 3.5 assists and 1.5 steals against 17th-ranked Kentucky and at No. 11 Texas A&M. Waters made two treys from 30-plus feet in the final 12 seconds to beat Texas A&M Saturday in College Station. The first came with LSU down five and 12 seconds left. The game winner came after A&M missed two free throws and an LSU timeout with 3.0 to play. Waters hit a 35-footer over two Aggies with 0.7 on the clock to give LSU the win.

Overall, Waters is averaging a team best 16.8 points a game, 3.7 rebounds, 6.1 assists and 2.3 steals. He is fifth in the league in scoring, first in assists and steals, eighth in field goal percentage (47.4%) and eighth in three-point percentage (41.8%).

Against Arkansas on Wednesday, Waters had his string of double figure scoring games stopped at four, but he still was important with eight assists. It was the first game this season he did not hit a three-pointers, going 0-of-4.

Waters first earned FOW honors after his opening game in which he scored 27 points, the most by a freshman in an opening game since 1976.

ESPN analyst Jay Bilas tweeted the following this past Sunday: "LSU's Tremont Waters is a terrific player, and one of the best freshmen in the country. What he did against Texas A&M at the end of the game was simply ridiculous. Houdini in short pants."

While Tack Minor had 10 assists in the same 2004-05 season, Waters becomes the first player to go back-to-back double figure assists since Randy Livingston as a redshirt freshman had three straight games of double figure assists in the 1994-95 season – 12 vs. Georgia State, 12 vs. Md-Baltimore and 11 vs. Florida ... This was the second of two set of three consecutive games in double figure assists that Livingston had that season.

Against Kentucky (1/3), Waters had another double double but it was points and rebounds with 18 points and 11 rebounds.

LSU leads the league in field goal percentage at 50.3 percent, the only team in the SEC shooting over 50 percent at this point of the season. Last year, LSU shot 45.1 percent from the field. The 50.3 percent is ranked 13th in the country.

LSU is continuing to try to improve its field goal percentage defense which after 15 games is now at its highest point in the conference standings at No. 11 at 43.2 percent. However, on the plus side, last year opponents shot over 47 percent against the Tigers.

LSU has now won eight straight games when shooting over 50 percent, dating back to last season.

**LSU INSIDE THE ARC**

For much of the non-conference season, LSU was 60 percent or better shooting from inside the arc, but LSU is now at 59.0 percent, No. 6 in the country according to TeamRankings.com. LSU's 15-game total is way up from last season when LSU shot 50.2% inside the arc.

Against Arkansas, LSU was 25-of-37 inside the arc.

**LSU WITH 25 TREYS IN FIRST TWO ROAD WINS**

While LSU has been shooting the ball better from the arc everywhere, in the first two road games, the Tigers made 13-of-26 trey attempts in the 71-61 road win at Memphis (12/29) and 12-of-28 (1/6) in the 69-68 win at A&M.

The 13 treys against Memphis tied the fourth most three-pointers LSU has made in a single game and the 11th time LSU has made 13 or more three-pointers in a single game:

The Tigers have helped themselves in their three-pointers made this year, 127 three-pointers for the season. LSU is averaging 8.5 threes a game, up from last year when the Tigers made 6.3 a contest. In the last couple of games, LSU has made up a wide difference in opponents three-point makes, now having a +4 on opponents (127-123). Opponents have taken 21 more attempts. LSU's 36.7 percent shooting percentage from the arc is sixth in the league. LSU last year shot 33.6 percent for three.

**FREE THROWS**

Earlier in the year, LSU was on the mark against Samford (11/16), making 19-of-20 for the game, including 16-of-16 in the first half. LSU's lone miss came in the first half with 2:38 to play after LSU made its first three of the night.

It marked the fourth time since 1966-67 for LSU to shoot at least 95% when attempting at least 20 FT's in a game:

After nine games, LSU was at an incredible 78.4 percent at the line, but now LSU is still at a good 74.0

percent (208-281), fifth in the league. That is still way ahead of the 69.6 percent that LSU shot at the line during the 2016-17 season.

LSU is making 13.9 free throws a game ... LSU has made 22 more free throws than opponents and has 15 more attempts.

#### OVER 20 ASSISTS AGAIN

For the third time this year, LSU was over 20 assists in the UNF game (12/22), this time recording 26 assists for the 43 buckets it made.

LSU had 29 assists in the Samford win in November and 22 assists in the win over UT-Martin, also in November. LSU has had five games of 30 assists or more, the last coming in December 2002.

LSU is averaging 15.7 assists per game, sixth in the league.

#### DUOP REATH'S 30 POINTS VS. UNCW EARNED HIM HIS SECOND CAREER SEC POW

LSU senior forward Duop Reath earned SEC Player of the Week honors for the second time in his LSU career after a huge scoring night against UNCW in LSU's 97-84 win on Dec. 10. The 6-11 native of Australia made a career high 13 field goals, including one three, and added 3-of-4 field goal attempts to finish with a career high 30 points.

Now Reath posted his second highest scoring game of his career with 24 points against Kentucky and now finally has his first double double of the year (eight over two years) after grabbing 11 rebounds. Reath was 11-of-17 in the game including 2-of-3 treys. He also had two assists and two blocks in 35 minutes.

Against A&M, Reath just missed back-to-back double doubles with nine points and 10 rebounds and had a good game against Arkansas in Fayetteville with 11 points, six rebounds and two blocks.

Reath is averaging 14.7 points per game and 9.0 rebounds in league games. Overall, he is almost even with last year's scoring average, scoring at a 12.5 clip and 5.5 rebounds a game. From the field he is 77-of-134 (57.5%, 2nd in the league).

#### THE OPPONENT – ALABAMA

Alabama comes into the game off a Tuesday home win against South Carolina, 76-62, The Tide is 2-2 in the league, having lost to Vanderbilt and Georgia on the road prior to coming home on Tuesday night.

Louisiana Sports Hall of Fame inductee Avery Johnson is in his third season as the head coach of the Tide after his distinguished career as a head coach in the NBA and ESPN analyst. He also played a part of his college basketball career at Southern University here in Baton Rouge before his playing and coaching career in the NBA.

Alabama has a 106-71 lead in the series, having won the last three games in the series, stopping a three-game winning streak for LSU. The Tigers lead the series, 48-32, in Baton Rouge. The teams have split the last 10 meetings. This is the first of two between the teams as LSU heads to Tuscaloosa for a Feb. 13 game, also on the SEC Network.

#### SKYLAR MAYS GOOD ON AND OFF THE FLOOR

It all fits in doesn't it – pre-med major; 4-plus GPA and starting guard on the team. Last year it was starting point guard for 25 of 31 games. This year it's still somewhat starting point guard because in Coach Wade's system, he believes in having two point-guard types out on the floor to smoothly run the offense through.

So far the numbers are good as he is averaging 12.1 points per game, 3.9 rebounds and 3.5 assists per game. In conference play, Mays is averaging 9.3 points and 4.0 assists.

Mays has had 10 games in double figure scoring, including nine-of-the-last-11 games. In LSU's last two games, both road wins, he has scored 23 points, hitting 4-of-9 three-pointers and 7-of-8 free throws.

Mays has posted at least five assists in 12 games in his career, five this season including six against A&M on Saturday.

For the season, Mays is 22-of-60 from three-point range (36.7 percent). He has been a consistently good force from the free throw line, making 37-of-42 for the season (88.1%) ... For his career he is 106-of-127 or 83.5%.

#### EPPTS' POST THIRD DOUBLE DOUBLE AT ARKANSAS

The four-year senior is working hard to make his final year a good one as he is an example of how much returning players have improved under the tutelage of Coach Wade. Epps had his third double double of the season at Arkansas with 13 points and 11 rebounds.

In December, it was back-to-back double doubles for the Ball, Louisiana native. After a 26 point, 16 rebounds game against Houston on Dec. 10, Epps came back with another double double of 16 points and 10 rebounds against SFA on Dec. 13.

In the two games, Epps scored 42 points and had 26 rebounds. He played 59 minutes, made 13-of-24 field goals, 4-of-8 3 FGs and 12-of-13 free throws.

His night of 26 rebounds and 16 rebounds marked just the third time since the start of the 2010-11 season, according to sports-reference.com, that an LSU player has had 25 points or more and 15 or more rebounds in a single game. Epps is also the only one of the three to be on a winning side in their game.

Epps has started the last 11 games for the Tigers and his first three SEC games were good ones as against Kentucky the senior posted 13 points on 6-of-11 shooting, including one trey. At A&M, he was 4-of-7 from the field with three of those three-pointers for 11 points with eight rebounds.

He is averaging 10.4 points per game and a team best 6.5 rebounds overall. Epps has made 55-of-102 field goals for 53.9 percent with 15 treys. In the three SEC games, he is averaging 12.3 points per game.

#### JC TRANSFER DARYL EDWARDS

Daryl Edwards is beginning to find his niche in the LSU system after only playing about a third of the time in the three games of the Maui Invitational. But from there his minutes increased and he has started the last five games for the Tigers.

The junior college transfer is averaging 5.9 points a contest. He has made 19 treys.

### BRANDON SAMPSON

Brandon Sampson is at full go since the Maui Invitational ankle sprain with his best game at Memphis when he scored 12 points with three treys.

Sampson has played nine total games this season with four starts, averaging 7.3 points, having made 25-of-49 field goals (51%) with nine treys.

Sampson played the first three games of the year and then sprained his left ankle in the first 30 seconds of the semifinal game with Notre Dame in Maui.

### RANDY ONWUASOR

Grad student Randy Onwuasor got the nod for the first five games that Brandon Sampson was out before coming off the bench in recent contests. Onwuasor was on his game in the Arkansas win Wednesday, hitting 4-of-6 field goals and all four free throw attempts. His best overall game came in the first game off the bench when he played 17 minutes and hit 5-of-9 field goals, including two treys in a 13-point night.

At this points in the season, Onwuasor is averaging 4.7 points per game and 1.9 rebounds. He is 24-of-48 from the field, making five treys and 13-of-16 from the free throw line.

### TWO LOUISIANA FRESHMAN COMING OFF BENCH

Brandon Rachal of Natchitoches-Central High in Natchitoches and Galen Alexander of Breaux Bridge (Lafayette Christian Academy) have also been looking for playing time with Rachal getting the bulk of the time of the freshman outside of Waters. Rachal has played in 14 games with a 16.9 minute per game average. He is posting at 5.3 points per game and 2.9 rebounds a game. Rachal is 29-of-55 from the field. Against A&M, Rachal played 16 minutes and hit 3-of-4 field goals for six points. He also scored six at Arkansas.

Alexander, who missed a lot of his senior season with knee surgery and was a bit slow in recovery, has played in eight games with a 2.1 points per game average and 2.4 rebounds.

### WAYDE SIMS GETS FIRST COLLEGE DOUBLE DOUBLE

Wayde Sims, the sophomore son of former LSU men's basketball player Wayne Sims, recorded his first college double up December 19 in a 20-minute stunt off the bench against Sam Houston.

Sims had 10 points and 10 rebounds to go with a career best three blocks. It was his fourth double figure scoring game this year and the second double figure rebound game at LSU. Sims, who has scored eight points each in four-of-the-last six games, is averaging 7.1 points and 3.5 rebounds. He has started eight games and played an average of 20.2 minutes.

Sims is 43-of-87 from the field (49.4%) with seven treys.
