Will Wade

Head Coach

2nd Year at LSU • 6th Year as a Head Coach

After laying a new foundation for the future of LSU basketball in Year 1, Will Wade enters his second year as head coach of the Tigers.

The first night Wade led the Tigers onto the floor of the Maravich Center was a night that signaled a new dawn for the storied program.

There had been plenty of excitement prior to the opening game as the first-year coach went all over the state speaking to groups about basketball.

But would people back that up by showing for the opening game?

They did to the tune of 11,856 at the Maravich Center, the largest opening night crowd since the start of Shaquille O’Neal’s final season of play at LSU in 1991-92.

It was the first of 18 wins that would lead LSU back to postseason play for the first-time since 2015 and produce the first postseason NIT win in Baton Rouge.

Wade became just the second coach in school history to take his first LSU team to postseason play.

The first-year coach delivered on what he promised – a team that would play hard, would represent the University well and players committed to building the program.

Wade and an experienced coaching staff put together a recruiting class that included two five-star players and two four-star players that helped the Tigers finish with the No. 3 recruiting class in the country leading into the 2018-19 season.

That new foundation for the future began on March 20, 2017, when Frank William “Will” Wade was named the 22nd head men’s basketball coach at LSU.

He arrived at LSU after a stellar two-year stint as the head coach at Virginia Commonwealth University with four years of very successful experience as a head basketball coach.

Wade was introduced to LSU fans at a special media event held in the middle of the LSU Student Union. Wade told the media and a large contingent of LSU students:

“I am so excited about the opportunity to lead this program and LSU Basketball back to the top of the SEC and back to regular, consistent NCAA Tournament appearances. We have been to four Final Fours. We have been to 20 NCAA Tournaments. We have 10 SEC Championships, and we are going to add to all three of those categories over our tenure here.”

Prior to his appointment at LSU, the native of Nashville, Tenn., directed VCU to a 51-20 record and two NCAA Tournament appearances. The 2016 Rams advanced to the second round of the tournament, defeating Oregon State before losing to Oklahoma. In 2017, VCU lost to St. Mary’s in the first round of the 2017 tourney.

Before becoming the head coach at VCU, Wade served as the head coach at Chattanooga for the 2013-14 and 2014-15 seasons.

Wade’s coaching start came at Clemson where he served as director of Basketball

Operations (2006-07) and Graduate Assistant (2005-06) after four seasons as a student manager (2002-05). In eight years as an assistant coach at Clemson (2005-07), Harvard (2007-09) and VCU (2009-13), the teams had a record of 177-97 with six postseason appearances (2005-13).

Wade is married to the former Lauren Deason, and the couple has one daughter, Caroline Elizabeth.

LAST GAME: LSU 91, UIW 50 (BATON ROUGE, 12/9/18)

The Tigers used a big run at the end of the first half to put this game away and finally get some traction in the game against Incarnate Word of the Southland Conference. LSU opened up a 10-point advantage some 6:30 into the game, but the Cardinals came back to cut the game to one point, 24-23, with 7:47 to go into the first half.

LSU used a 27-6 run the rest of the first half to take a 51-29 halftime advantage. LSU would lead by as many as 45 late in the second half of the game.

Two freshman, Ja'vonte Smart and Naz Reid, led the way with 16 points apiece. The pair combined to shoot 13-of-18 from the field and 3-of-5 from the arc. Smart had five assists and Reid three assists, with Reid having three steals and Smart two. Senior transfer Kavell Bigby-Williams had 14 points and 10 rebounds with Skylar Mays getting 13 points, six assists and four steals.

The Tigers shot 55.7 percent (34-of-61) with 10 treys in the game while holding Incarnate Word to 31.9 percent (15-of-47). LSU out rebounded the Cardinals, 43-20 with 13 offensive rebounds and the Tigers had a 44-16 advantage in points in the paint.

OTHER LSU-UIW NOTES

KAVELL BIGBY-WILLIAMS DOUBLES -- In his second career start Dec. 1 against Grambling, the

senior transfer from Oregon had nine points and nine blocks (5 in the first half, 4 in the second half) in 24 total minutes of playing time. KBW became the first LSU Tiger to block nine shots in a game since Tyrus Thomas blocked nine shots against Tennessee January 14, 2006.

Now against UIW, KBW gets his first LSU double double with 14 points on 6-of-9 shooting and 10 rebounds, six offensive.

7 STRAIGHT – Skylar Mays getting 13 points gave him seven straight double figure scoring games at present, the longest streak of any player in Will Wade’s two years at LSU (Tremont Waters had two streaks of six last year).

30 PERCENT SHOOTING – UIW shot from 31.9 percent from the field against the Tigers. That makes five-of-the-last six games that LSU has forced the opposition to shoot under 40 percent:

Vs. Louisiana Tech – 24-of-61, 39.3%

Vs. Charleston – 18-of-53, 34.0%

Vs. Florida State – 29-of-76, 38.2%

Vs. Grambling – 20-of-51, 39.2%

Vs. UIW – 15-of-47, 31.9%

LSU is shooting 75 points better from the field this season than opponents (49.7 to 42.2) and has made 49 more field goals in just 20 more attempts.

20 + LEADS – LSU’s run over the last part of the first half gave LSU a 22-point lead at the half. LSU is now 80-0 in games in which it leads by 20 or more at the half since the 1966-67 season.

PRACTICE, PRACTICE, PRACTICE

Wednesday’s game with Houston will only be LSU’s third game since finishing the AdvoCare Invitational in Orlando on Nov. 25. This was after playing seven games in the first 25 days of the season.

LSU had a week to practice before a Dec. 1 game against Grambling and then, while battling final exams, had plenty of time to practice before this past Sunday’s game against UIW.

LSU will have more time to practice between games and work on the plan moving forward after leaving Monday for this game and heading straight to Vegas for Saturday’s neutral site game against Saint Mary’s.

Then LSU will have time to return home to work on things for games on Dec. 21 (Furman) and Dec. 28 (ULM) before a lengthy break to prepare for the opening of SEC play on Jan. 8.

IT’S NOT RPI BUT NET

The tool that the NCAA selection committee will use to help determine the tournament field is called the NET (NCAA Evaluation Tool), which relies on game results, strength of schedule, game location, scoring margin (capped at 10 points), net offensive and defensive efficiency and the quality of wins and losses.

In very early and still processing NET showings through Sunday, LSU is at No. 39, with its 7-2 record. LSU is 0-1 in quadrant 1 play (home 1-30, neutral 1-50, away 1-75) and 1-1 in quadrant 2 wins (home 31-75, neutral 51-100, away 76-135). Three of LSU’s wins are in quadrant 3 and three in quadrant 4

LSU’s opponent’s schedule NET is 128 and that is ranked 34th best in Division I.

LSU NOW AT 13 STRAIGHT WINS IN THE MARAVICH CENTER

The win over UIW on Dec. 9 gave LSU 13 consecutive wins in the Maravich Center dating back to the final seven home games of a year ago. The Tigers won six regular season SEC home games to conclude the 2017-18 regular season and the NIT game with UL-Lafayette.

The present 13-game win streak is tied for the eighth longest in Maravich Center history and the longest since LSU won 17 straight at the end of the 2007-08 and start of 2008-09 seasons ... A win Sunday will give LSU a tie for the eighth longest win streak in the building:

ON THE ROAD

The road started out pretty well for LSU last season in Will Wade's first campaign, winning road games at Memphis, Texas A&M and Arkansas to open play away from home. But since then, the Tigers hit the skids losing seven straight in the regular season (Vanderbilt, Auburn, Tennessee, Florida, Alabama, Georgia and South Carolina) and a second-round NIT game at Utah.

All-time, LSU is 419-636 on the road or a win percentage of 39.7 percent.

FORMER BASEBALL PLAYER SCORES IN BACK-TO-BACK GAMES

Former LSU baseball pitcher Will Reese scored his first two collegiate points in the Grambling game (12/1) and had another two against UIW (12/9). He joins a group of former players to have handled the two sport aspect at LSU. He was a scholarship pitcher for the baseball team for two seasons before deciding to walk-on to the men's basketball team at LSU, playing basketball for the first time since leading Anacoco High to two state titles.

He is the first two-sport player to score for LSU basketball since Robert Royal on Jan. 17, 2000 (FB, BKB) and he is the first LSU baseball player to record points since Lyle Mouton on March 17, 1989. Of course the SEC Network and ESPN's Ben McDonald also participated in both basketball and baseball in his time at LSU in the mid-1980s.

KBW AND THE BLOCKS

As of Monday, Kavell Bigby-Williams nine blocks against Grambling on Dec. 1 is tied for second most in a single game this season in the NCAA with the top two being in-state players:

Jakeenan Gant, UL-Lafayette (vs. Southern) 10

Kavell Bigby-Williams, LSU (vs. Grambling) 9

Nate Reuvers, Wisconsin (vs. Stanford) 9

Brandon Gilbeck, Western Illinois (vs. Eastern Illinois) 9

Bigby-Williams averages 2.56 blocks per game and is ranked 22nd in the country. He is T2 in the SEC in block average.

As a team, LSU is 28th in the NCAA in blocks per game at 5.2 and 31st in the nation in total blocks at 47. However, LSU's team average is only ranked eighth in the SEC.

KBW just missed becoming the third person in the last 30 years to have double figure blocks in a game. Shaquille O'Neal had games with 12 blocks (once), 11 (3 times) and 10 blocks (twice). Stromile Swift had 11 in a game once.

Since the start of the 2001-02 season, KBW joined the following LSU players who have had six or more blocks in a game are: Kavell Bigby-Williams (1), Tyrus Thomas (3), Chris Johnson (4), Jordan Mickey (4), Brandon Bass (2), Glen Davis (1), Anthony Randolph (1) and Malcolm White (1).

Bigby-Williams has hit his stride in the last few games and has been hard to stop offensively once he got rolling:

Vs. Oklahoma State (11/25) – 6-of-9 FG – 12 points, 7 rebounds

Vs. Grambling State (12/1) – 4-of-6 FG – 9 points, 5 rebounds

Vs. Incarnate Word (12/9) – 6-of-9 FG – 14 points, 10 rebounds

Last 3 games – 14-of-24 FG – 35 points, 22 rebounds

Earlier against Memphis (11/13), KBW hit 7-of-7 field goals in scoring 14 points.

For the season, Bigby-Williams is averaging 7.7 points and 4.8 rebounds. He is averaging 17.3 minutes a game and is 30-of-44 from the field (68.2 percent).

STEALS ARE GOOD IN BASKETBALL

LSU has some very good steal numbers in the first nine games with 87 total (9.7 spg), which the total is ranked 18th in the country and second in the league and the per game average is ranked 12th in the NCAA and second in the league.

LSU's Tremont Waters is ranked first in the league and second in the nation at 3.0 steals per game while Skylar Mays is seventh in the league at 1.78 per game and Ja'vonte Smart is T8 in the league at 1.67. Waters total steals of 27 is ranked first in the league and fourth in the nation, while Mays is fifth in the SEC (16) and Smart is sixth in the league at 15.

LSU averaged 7.6 steals per game a year ago.

LSU OVER 50 PERCENT

The Tigers posted a 55.7 percent shooting percentage against UIW (12/9), the fifth time this season that LSU has shot at least 50 percent for a game:

UNCG – 30-of-54 – 55.6%

Memphis – 34-of-63 – 54.0%

Charleston – 27-of-52 – 51.9%

Florida State – 27-of-52 – 51.9%

UIW – 34-of-61 – 55.7%

LSU is 4-1 this year when shooting 50 percent or better, 16-1 in the Will Wade era. That one loss came in the Florida State game (11/23), stopping a 16-game winning streak dating back to once at the end of the 2016-17 season when LSU shot 50 percent or better. LSU is 71-7 since the 2007-08 season when shooting 50 percent or better from the floor.

The 34 field goals LSU made against UIW (12/9) was T5 in the Will Wade era at LSU.

SHOOTING THE THREE

The Tigers have not shot the ball from the arc as well as they did last year but in the three games of the AdvoCare Invitational did make 26 treys compared to 25 in the first four games of the season

Against Grambling (12/1), the Tigers were 9-of-21 or 42.9 percent, the second best single-game percentage of the season, topped only by the 9-of-18 (50%) shooting in the second game of the season against UNCG. Versus UIW (12/9), the Tigers hit double figures in threes for the second time this season:

Vs. Florida State – 11-of-26 – 42.3%

Vs. UIW – 10-of-26 – 38.5%

After making 31 treys in the first five games, LSU has made 39 treys in the last four contests.

LSU is eighth in the SEC in three-point percentage (70-of-204, 34.3%). Opponents have made seven more three-pointers than the Tigers so far this season (77-of-201, 38.3%). LSU is 12th in the SEC in three-point field goal defense. Last season, LSU made a school record 268 treys in 33 games (268-744) and shot 34.6 percent from the arc.

Before UIW shot just 21.4 percent from the arc (3-of-14), the two previous opponents -- Oklahoma State (11/25) and Grambling (12/1) -- combined to make 13-of-23 from the arc. Three opponents -- UNCG (19), Memphis (10) and Louisiana Tech (11) -- recorded double digit three-point make games.

INSIDE THE ARC – LSU EIGHTH IN DI

LSU continues to lead the SEC and is No. 8 in the country in shooting percentage inside the arc at 59.1 percent after shooting 68.6 percent inside the arc against Incarnate Word (24-of-35).

The Tigers shot 56 percent inside the arc a year ago. Ironically, this is a rebound for the Tigers who in its previous two games did not shoot as good inside the arc -- 47.4 percent against Grambling and 46.3 percent against Oklahoma State.

Second in the SEC in two-point percentage is Mississippi State at No. 29 at 57.1 percent.

Ole Miss is the second best team in the SEC at No. 23 at 57.4 percent inside the arc.

FREE THROWS

LSU shot below 70 percent at the three-game AdvoCare Invitational at 69.8 percent (30-of-43).

Again, like three-point shooting, opponents were at the line more, making 46-of-64 for 71.9 percent.

The Tigers started the season with a couple of its best free throw games in years making 24-of-31 against Southeastern (11/6), 28-of-31 against UNCG (11/9) and 12-of-16 against Memphis (11/13).

In the UNCG game, the Tigers hit 22 in a row at the free throw line to start the game before missing.

In four-of-the-last-five games, opponents have made more free throws than the Tigers:

Vs. Charleston – LSU – 7-of-10; Opponents – 14-of-22

Vs. Florida State – LSU – 11-of-13; Opponents – 12-of-17

Vs. Oklahoma State – LSU – 12-of-20; Opponents – 20-of-25

Vs. UIW – LSU – 13-of-17; Opponents – 17-of-23

For the season, LSU is 133-of-181 or 73.5 percent ... The opponents for the season is 113-of-165 or 68.5 percent. LSU is +20 on makes and +16 on attempts. LSU is fourth in the league in free throw percentage.

WILL WADE

The native of Nashville graduate of Franklin Road Academy in Nashville won his 100th game as a head coach during last season ... Now in his sixth season as a head coach (2 at Chattanooga, 2 at VCU and 2 at LSU), he has reestablished an interest in basketball at LSU and established a new culture for this program as it moves forward ... This from one of the youngest head coaches in the so-called power 5 major conferences this season (SEC, ACC, Big 12, Big 10, Pac 12) ... THREE-GUARD SYSTEM

Soon after Coach Wade arrived at LSU, it became very clear that he believed in trying to have two-point guards on the court to run his offense.

Last season that meant Tremont Waters and Skylar Mays who combined to average 27.2 points (15.9 for Waters, 11.3 for Mays) and a combined 8.9 assists.

Now Coach Wade has started three point guards in every game – sophomore Waters, junior Mays and freshman Ja'vonte Smart. While they are not on the court together all the time – Darius Days is now playing some three spot as well – the trio has become a solid group for Coach Wade to depend on.

In nine games, the trio has combined for 331 points, 86 rebounds, 103 assists and 58 steals while shooting a combined 116-of-244 from the field with 41 treys and 58-of-70 at the free throw line. The points are spread like this: Mays 125 (13.9 ppg); Waters 103 (11.4 ppg); Smart 103 (11.4 ppg)

10 -- vs. UT-Martin

So far this season, Waters is averaging 11.4 points per game and 5.6 assists per game. So far this season, Tremont is No. 6 in the SEC and 49th in the NCAA stats in assists while in steals Waters is the league leader at 3.0 a game.

Only one player, Clarence Caesar back in the early 1990s, averaged 3.0 steals a game for a season for LSU. Waters needs six steals to become the 27th player to get to 100 career steals.

Waters has struggled from the arc this season hitting just 11-of-35 three-point attempts in the first nine games. Overall, he is at 43.4 percent hitting 36-of-83 from the field.

Waters for his career has dished out 248 assists in 42 career games. That ranks 21st among the 34 LSU players who have posted 200 career assists. Waters needs four to pass Tommy Hess, who played in the early 1970s, for the 20th spot.

SKYLAR MAYS

Junior guard Skylar Mays joined teammate Tremont Waters with his own ESPN SportsCenter moment against Memphis (11/13) when he delivered an emphatic driving dunk that registered as the third best player of the day. Mays would score 19 points on 6-of-11 shooting, including three treys. He has 39 career double figure scoring games at LSU.

Mays had an outstanding AdvoCare Invitational in which he led the team, averaging 17.0 points per game, 3.3 rebounds and 3.3 assists per game. He followed that up with two more double figure scoring games to run his current streak to seven consecutive double figure scoring game and he is averaging 13.9 points for the season. He is also averaging 3.6 rebounds and 2.6 assists a contest.

The junior is one of 34 players to have at least 200 career assists and is one of 27 players to have 100 career steals.

The second team Academic A-A chosen by CoSIDA members has a 4.01 GPA and is majoring in pre-med/kinesiology ... In addition to the CoSIDA honor last spring, he was honored by the LSU Black Faculty and Staff Caucus at their annual awards presentation as one of the recipients of the Jesse Owens Student Award for the highest GPA by undergraduate student-athletes.

Mays leads the team in field goals (43) and 3 point field goals (19). He is shooting 53.1 percent from the field and 43.2 percent from the arc.

Mays is presently 14th among active career scorers with 755 points and he is seventh in the league in career active leaders with 233. He is third behind only Q Weatherspoon of Mississippi State and KeVaughn Allen of Florida in active career steals in the SEC with 108.

JA'VONTE SMART

Smart is averaging 11.4 points per game, 3.6 rebounds and 3.3 assists a contest. He is shooting 46 percent from the field (37-80) with 11 treys. He has scored 16 points three times (against Louisiana Tech, 11/16; vs. Florida State, 11/23; and, most recently Sunday against UIW (12/9). Against the Cardinals, he was 6-of-10 from the field with two treys.

In the last four games, he has dished out a combined 22 assists, highlighted by eight against Florida State.

REBOUNDING NUMBERS

The Tigers were outrebounded in four straight games – versus Louisiana Tech (11/16), Charleston (11/22), Florida State (11/23) and Oklahoma State (12/1) – before out rebounding Grambling by a 45-24 count and Incarnate Word, 43-20. In the last two games the Tigers also had margins of 16-5 against Grambling and 13-4 versus UIW on the offensive boards.

LSU's Emmitt Williams, who has two double doubles this year, leads the team in rebounding by a good margin, averaging 7.1 boards a game. Of his 57 rebounds, 24 are offensive. Williams is 9th in the league in rebounding average.

Darius Days is second at (5.4, 22-27) and Naz Reid is third in average at 4.9 a game. LSU is T10 in the league in rebound average at 37.8 a game and third in rebound defense at 31.1 a contest.

DARIUS DAYS STARTS LAST TWO

LSU replaced one freshman for another in the starting lineup as Darius Days got the start against Grambling (12/1) and responded with his first double figure scoring game since the season opener. He scored 13 against Grambling with nine rebounds, just missing a double double. Days hit 5-of-8 from the field with a trey and also had three steals in 25 minutes.

Against Incarnate Word, Days played 20 minutes in his second start scoring nine points with eight rebounds.

Days is averaging 7.3 points per game, shooting 51.2% overall (22-of-43) with five treys and 17-of-20 at the free throw line.

NAZ REID

Since Coach Wade's move back to more of an inside-out offense that relies on some paint touches as part of the flow of the offense, Reid's early season aggressiveness has returned and it really showed in the second half of the UIW game (12/9) as he scored 14-of-his-16 points in that 20 minutes on 6-of-6 shooting, including one trey. For the game, Reid was 7-of-8 overall, 1-of-2 from the arc and 1-of-2 at the free throw line for 16 points, seven boards, three assists and three steals in 22 minutes.

The New Jersey freshman has five double figure scoring games and is shooting 48.8 percent from the floor (42-of-86) with 10 treys. He is averaging 12.1 points per game and 4.9 rebounds.

MARLON TAYLOR

Coach Wade has been talking about Marlon Taylor and his athletic ability and his hope that he will be a big asset for the Tigers as SEC begins next month. Against Incarnate Word, Taylor played 33 minutes with six points and seven rebounds. This comes after a Grambling game on Dec. 1 in which he scored nine points in 21 minutes, his highest scoring game since hitting for 15 points in 15 minutes in the Nov. 6 opener against Southeastern.

For the season, Taylor is averaging 15.7 minutes a game and 5.1 points and 2.4 rebounds a contest.

EMMITT WILLIAMS

The freshman missed the Incarnate Word with a lip injury suffered in practice last week but he is listed as probable for the game on Wednesday. Williams in eight games is averaging 8.5 points a game and a team leading 7.1 rebounds.

Williams is shooting 26-of-41 from the field (63.4 percent) and has two double doubles – 12 points, 10 rebounds versus Southeastern (11/6) and, 11 points, 10 rebounds vs. Memphis (11/13).

SERIES VERSUS HOUSTON

This will be the 20th time the Tigers and Cougars have met and the ninth time in Houston. This is the fourth straight season the teams have met in a pair of home-and-home contracts. LSU has won the last two years, both in Baton Rouge (84-65 in 2016 and 80-77 in a down to the wire game in 2017). The last game in the old Hofheinz Pavilion between the teams was also a wild one in 2015 as Houston won, 105-98, in overtime.

The Tigers last won in Houston in 2011, 59-58. The Cougars lead the series in Houston, 6-2.

The Cougars come into the contest undefeated at 8-0 after a 63-53 win over Oklahoma State on Saturday in Stillwater. Armoni Brooks had 23 points and eight rebounds, hitting seven three-pointers in the contest. Corey Davis, Jr., had 14 points and seven rebounds with Breason Brady getting 10 points and eight rebounds. Houston shot 41.0 percent (25-of-61) with 12 treys. The Cougars out rebounded the Cowboys, 44-33. Houston had a 26-24 advantage in the paint and OSU had the 18-16 margin in points off turnovers. One telling stat was a 13-3 top for Houston in second chance points.

Veteran coach Kelvin Sampson is the head coach at Houston. This is his fifth season at UH.

ROAD TRIP CONTINUES TO VEGAS

This six-day road adventure continues on Saturday night in Las Vegas when LSU takes on Saint Mary's in the second half of the Neon Hoops Showcase doubleheader at T-Mobile Arena. The Tigers and Gaels will tip at 10 p.m. CT (8 p.m. in Las Vegas) in a game televised by ESPNU and broadcast on the LSU Sports Radio Network. UNLV and BYU play the opener of the doubleheader.

The Tigers next home game isn't until Friday, Dec. 21, against Furman.
