2nd Year at LSU • 6th Year as a Head Coach

After laying a new foundation for the future of LSU basketball in Year 1, Will Wade enters his second year as head coach of the Tigers.

The first night Wade led the Tigers onto the floor of the Maravich Center was a night that signaled a new dawn for the storied program.

There had been plenty of excitement prior to the opening game as the first-year coach went all over the state speaking to groups about basketball.

But would people back that up by showing for the opening game?

They did to the tune of 11,856 at the Maravich Center, the largest opening night crowd since the start of Shaquille O’Neal’s final season of play at LSU in 1991-92.

It was the first of 18 wins that would lead LSU back to postseason play for the first-time since 2015 and produce the first postseason NIT win in Baton Rouge.

Wade became just the second coach in school history to take his first LSU team to postseason play.

The first-year coach delivered on what he promised – a team that would play hard, would represent the University well and players committed to building the program.

Wade and an experienced coaching staff put together a recruiting class that included two five-star players and two four-star players that helped the Tigers finish with the No. 3 recruiting class in the country leading into the 2018-19 season.

That new foundation for the future began on March 20, 2017, when Frank William “Will” Wade was named the 22nd head men’s basketball coach at LSU.

He arrived at LSU after a stellar two-year stint as the head coach at Virginia Commonwealth University with four years of very successful experience as a head basketball coach.

Wade was introduced to LSU fans at a special media event held in the middle of the LSU Student Union. Wade told the media and a large contingent of LSU students:

“I am so excited about the opportunity to lead this program and LSU Basketball back to the top of the SEC and back to regular, consistent NCAA Tournament appearances. We have been to four Final Fours. We have been to 20 NCAA Tournaments. We have 10 SEC Championships, and we are going to add to all three of those categories over our tenure here.”

Prior to his appointment at LSU, the native of Nashville, Tenn., directed VCU to a 51-20 record and two NCAA Tournament appearances. The 2016 Rams advanced to the second round of the tournament, defeating Oregon State before losing to Oklahoma. In 2017, VCU lost to St. Mary’s in the first round of the 2017 tourney.

Before becoming the head coach at VCU, Wade served as the head coach at Chattanooga for the 2013-14 and 2014-15 seasons.

Wade’s coaching start came at Clemson where he served as director of Basketball

Operations (2006-07) and Graduate Assistant (2005-06) after four seasons as a student manager (2002-05). In eight years as an assistant coach at Clemson (2005-07), Harvard (2007-09) and VCU (2009-13), the teams had a record of 177-97 with six postseason appearances (2005-13).

Wade is married to the former Lauren Deason, and the couple has one daughter, Caroline Elizabeth.

LAST GAME: LSU 88, ALABAMA 79 (January 8, 2019, Baton Rouge)

LSU used a strong first half to get the Southeastern Conference season off on a good start with the home win over Alabama on Tuesday.

The Tigers won their 16th consecutive game at home dating back to last year and its seventh straight SEC home game dating back to last year.

The Tigers put the game in good position to take the win in a first 20 minutes in which they shot 53.6 percent from the field, including 8-of-10 from the three-point arc. The Tigers over the last 5:50 of the half, out-scored Alabama 19-7 to take the lead from 24-21 to 43-28. LSU would score the first four points of the second half and lead by as many as 19 points with 19 minutes to play in the game.

Tremont Waters led the Tigers with 19 points and seven assists, while Ja'vonte Smart off the bench had 15 points and five assists. Darius Days had 14 points as did Kavell Bigby-Williams who also added a season high 13 rebounds and five blocks.

The Tigers shot 49.1 percent from the field hitting 10-of-15 three-pointers. Alabama shot 40.3 percent from the field (25-of-62) for 40.3% and 7-of-24 from the arc. LSU was good from the free throw line, making 22-of-27 for the game (81.5%), including 17-of-21 in the second half.

SMART CONTRIBUTES ON FINAL 19 OF FIRST HALF

Freshman Ja'vonte Smart had what has to be a rarity in that in LSU's 19-7 first-half closing run against Alabama, he either scored or got the assist on all 19 points. Here's the breakdown after Alabama cut it to 24-21: with 5:54 to go in the half:

- 27-21 – Three pointer by Darius Days; SMART on the assist.**
- 29-21 – Two free throws by SMART**

SEC OPENERS

The win by LSU against Alabama gave the Tigers 45 wins in 87 Southeastern Conference openers dating back to the 1933 season ... The win by LSU was its last home conference opening win since Jan. 7, 2012 when LSU defeated Ole Miss, 81-55 ... LSU's last opening SEC win home or road came in 2016 at Vanderbilt.

LSU will be trying to go 2-0 in the league for the first time since 2016 when LSU opened with a road win over Vanderbilt and a home win over No. 9 Kentucky.

LAST 4 GAMES – WINS VERSUS SAINT MARY'S, NO. 24 FURMAN, ULM, ALABAMA

In LSU's last four games – a 78-74 win versus Saint Mary's (in Las Vegas), a 75-57 win over No. 24 Furman, an 81-69 win over ULM – the Tigers have averaged 80.5 points per game, while giving up 69.8 a game. LSU has shot 50.4 percent from the field with 28 treys, while opponents shot 41.0 percent with 31 treys. LSU was 62-of-83 from the free throw line. LSU had a 34.2-32.0 rebound average advantage.

LSU JUMPS IN NET

The tool that the NCAA selection committee will use to help determine the tournament field is called the NET (NCAA Evaluation Tool), which relies on game results, strength of schedule, game location, scoring margin (capped at 10 points), net offensive and defensive efficiency and the quality of wins and losses.

After play on Jan. 9, the Tigers have risen from 26 to 22 in the NET, one of three SEC teams in the top 22 of the NCAA Evaluation Toll.

LSU is 0-2 (Florida State, Houston) in quadrant 1 play (home 1-30, neutral 1-50, away 1-75) and 6-1 in quadrant 2 wins (Saint Mary's, Charleston, UNCG, Memphis, Charleston, Alabama)(home 31-75, neutral 51-100, away 76-135). Two of LSU's wins are in quadrant 3 and three in quadrant 4.

LSU's opponent's schedule NET is 13th best in Division I.

TIGERS OWN 16-GAME WINNING STREAK AT MARAVICH CENTER

The win over ULM (12/21) extended LSU's winning streak at the Maravich Center to 16 games dating back to the final seven home games of a year ago. The Tigers won six regular season SEC home games to conclude the 2017-18 regular season and the NIT game with UL-Lafayette to reach seven and now eight in this 2018-19 season.

The present 16-game win streak is tied for the fifth longest in Maravich Center history and the longest since LSU won 17 straight at the end of the 2007-08 and start of 2008-09 seasons:

The first number is offensive rating (how many points per 100 possessions the player produces) and the second number is usage rate (percentage of possessions a players "ends" with a make, miss, turnover).

TOUGH NON-CONFERENCE SCHEDULE

The Tigers non-conference schedule had plenty of possible ups and downs, including a win over No. 24 and undefeated Furman in December. LSU was 10-3 against what was the fifth toughest schedule in the country based on record of the opposition as of Jan. 4. LSU's 13 non-conference opponents stood at 124-51 (70.9%).

Right now with a league game thrown in LSU's schedule is seventh toughest with opponents having a win percentage of 69.5 percent (141-62). LSU's remaining opposition is at 69.8 percent (157-68). The cumulative percentage of 69.6 percent is ranked 15th toughest presently in the NCAA.

STEALS ARE GOOD IN BASKETBALL

LSU has some very good steal numbers in the first 14 games with 138 total (9.9 spg), with the total and average are ranked second in the SEC and eighth in the country.

LSU's Tremont Waters is ranked first in the league in both steals average (3.0) and total steals (42). He is third in the nation in steals per game and ninth in total nationally.

Skylar Mays is ranked fourth in the league in both steals average (1.9) and T3 in total steals (26). That is ranked 89th in the nation in average and 99th in total steals in the NCAA stats.

LSU is +2.3 over last year's steal average of 7.6 a game.

Waters had eight steals in the ULM game (12/28), the second time (last year vs. A&M at home) that Waters had eight steals in a game. The eight steals is tied for most in the league in a single game by an individual this year. That number is also tied for the second most in a single game in LSU history:

LSU is 6-1 this year when shooting 50 percent or better, 18-1 in the Will Wade era. That one loss came in the Florida State game (11/23), stopping a 16-game winning streak dating back to once at the end of the 2016-17 season when LSU shot 50 percent or better. LSU is 79-7 since the 2007-08 season when shooting 50 percent or better from the floor.

AN AMAZING NIGHT SHOOTING THE THREE

The Tigers shot an amazing 80 percent from the arc in the first half against Alabama (1/8), hitting 8-of-10, including five in the final six minutes of the first half when LSU expanded the lead from three to 15 at the half. LSU finished the game 10-of-15 or 66.7 percent overall.

It marked the fourth time LSU has shot 66 percent or better when attempting at least 10 three-pointers in a game:

70.6% at South Alabama (12-17), 11/28/2010 (fifth all-time in SEC)
66.7% vs. Alabama (10-15), 1/8/2019 (T10 all-time in SEC)
66.7% vs. Vanderbilt (10-15), 2/12/2003 (T10 all-time in SEC)
66.7% at Auburn (8-12), 2/13/1993 (T10 all-time in SEC)

The Tigers are averaging 7.4 treys a game, compared to last year when LSU made a record 268 treys in 33 games (8.1 a game).

The Alabama game was the third time this season (13 in Coach Wade's LSU tenure) LSU has hit double figure treys:

Vs. UIW – 10-of-26 – 38.5%
Vs. Alabama – 10-of-15 – 66.7%

LSU is ninth in the SEC in three-point percentage (103-of-296, 34.8%), 151 nationally. Opponents have made nine more three-pointers than the Tigers so far this season (112-of-317, 35.3%). LSU is 11th in the SEC in three-point field goal defense and accordingly only 252 nationally.

Three opponents – UNCG (19), Memphis (10) and Louisiana Tech (11) – recorded double digit three-point make games.

Tremont Waters and Skylar Mays are in a battle right now to see who will be the 21st LSU player with 100 career treys ... Mays enters the weekend with 94 career three-pointers and Waters has 93 treys.

INSIDE THE ARC

LSU continues to have its best games from two-point range at the Maravich Center where it is shooting over 58 percent at home.

For the season, LSU is No. 18 in the country in shooting percentage inside the arc at 57.0 percent for the season. The Tigers are second in the league in shooting inside the arc.

The Tigers are +0.8 over last year after shooting 56.2 percent inside the arc a year ago.

FREE THROWS

After two games making just 9-of-15 against Furman (12/21) and 9-of-16 against ULM (12/28), the Tigers made 22-of-27 in the Alabama game, including 17-of-21 in the second half. LSU is fourth in the league in free throw percentage at 74.2 percent (224-of-302). LSU is No. 51 in the nation in free throw percentage.

Opponents are 199-of-279 from the line (71.3%). The Tigers are +25 in free throw makes on 23 more attempts.

WILL WADE

The native of Nashville graduate of Franklin Road Academy in Nashville won his 100th game as a head coach during last season ... Now in his sixth season as a head coach (2 at Chattanooga, 2 at VCU and 2 at LSU), as he enters his second SEC season in his 47th game as LSU coach, he has reestablished an interest in basketball at LSU and established a new culture for this program as it moves forward ... This from one of the youngest head coaches in the so-called major conferences in college basketball this season (SEC, ACC, Big 12, Big 10, Pac 12, Big East, AAC) ... The sophomore is second on the team in scoring at 12.9 points per game and is averaging 5.6 assists per game. He is sixth in the league in assists and is No. 36 nationally.

In the last four games, Waters scoring average has gone up +1.6 and he has had 27 assists and 12 steals in those contests.

Waters in the Furman game became the 35th player in LSU history to get 100 career steals. With all the assists of late, he has already moved to 14th place on the career assists list with 277. He is 14 behind No. 13 who happens to be LSU's present day Director of Student-Athlete Development. Mitchell played as a freshman on LSU's NCAA Final Four team in 2006.

SKYLAR MAYS

The junior guard from Baton Rouge has had three double figure games in the present LSU win streak with 14 points versus Saint Mary's, 16 against Furman and 14 versus ULM. He was 15-of-24 from the field in those three games from the field with 5-of-11 from the arc and 9-of-10 from the free throw line.

He didn't score in double figures against Alabama (1/8) but did have eight points with two assists and two steals.

For the season Mays is averaging a team high 13.1 points per game, 3.3 rebounds, 2.4 assists and 1.9 steals per game.

The second team Academic A-A chosen by CoSIDA members has a 4.01 GPA and is majoring in pre-med/kinesiology ... In addition to the CoSIDA honor last spring, he was honored by the LSU Black Faculty and Staff Caucus at their annual awards presentation as one of the recipients of the Jesse Owens Student Award for the highest GPA by undergraduate student-athletes.

Mays, who leads the team in three-point field goals (26) is shooting 51.7 percent from the floor (62-120) and 26-of-63 from the arc (41.3 percent). He is also exceptional at the line, making 34-of-38 free throws for 89.5%.

Mays is presently 14th among active career scorers in the SEC with 814 points and he is seventh in the league in career active assists leaders with 244. He is third behind only Q Weatherspoon of Mississippi State and KeVaughn Allen of Florida in active career steals in the SEC with 118.

JA'VONTE SMART

After struggling in the first two games of LSU's present win streak, scoring just a combined two points against Saint Mary's (12/15) and Furman (12/21) and making just 1-of-12 field goal attempts, the freshman has rallied back with 10 points against ULM (12/28) and 15 in the win over Alabama.

He came off the bench for the first time in college against the Crimson Tide hitting 4-of-11 overall and 3-of-5 from the arc to go with five assists, just one turnover and one steal in 29 minutes.

The Baton Rouge native has delivered nine double figure scoring games this season including 18 at Houston (12/12) and 16 versus Louisiana Tech, Florida State and Incarnate Word.

Against Tech he had seven field goals with two treys with six field goals and two treys against Florida State. Versus UIW he also hit six field goals and two treys in the win. Against Houston, Smart in 36 minutes hit for six field goals, one trey and was 5-of-5 at the free throw line.

Smart enters the weekend averaging 10.6 points per game, fourth on the team, 3.0 rebounds and 2.8 assists.

Since going 0-2 at the free throw line against Oklahoma State (11/25), Smart is 15-16 at the line in the last seven games. For the season, Smart is 29-of-34 at the line.

MARLON TAYLOR

The junior college transfer started his first game versus Saint Mary's has been part of the three and

four-guard lineup the last four games ... Taylor has scored 25 points over the four games, most on athletic dunks and alley oops from Tremont Waters and Skylar Mays.

For the season, he is averaging 5.9 points and 2.8 rebounds a game.

Taylor has two double figure games, his debut against Southeastern (11/6) with 15 and 11 against Houston (12/12). In that game, Taylor was a very important 9-of-11 at the free throw line in a free throw shooting contest in a season when he is just 17-of-28 at the line (60.7 percent).

Taylor has made 29-of-63 field goals (46 percent) with seven treys.

THREE, FOUR-GUARD OFFENSE

LSU and Coach Will Wade had consistently run three guards in the starting lineup for the first 14 games of the season – 10 games with Waters, Smart and Mays before two games with Smart, Mays and Taylor in the lineup with Waters coming off the bench. Against Alabama, the three guards were Waters, Mays and Taylor.

The one exception was against ULM (12/28), when based on the matchup, Coach Wade started four guards for the first time at LSU with Smart, Mays, Taylor and Waters in the starting lineup.

LSU's Emmitt Williams, who has two double doubles this year, leads the team in rebounding at 6.2 boards a game. Of his 81 rebounds, 36 are offensive. Williams is T13 in the SEC in rebounding average.

Naz Reid is at 5.4 rebounds a game with Kavell Bigby-Williams at 5.1. LSU is 11 in the league in rebound average at 36.6 a game and sixth in rebound defense at 32.5 a contest.

KBW AND THE BLOCKS

Through play on Wednesday, Kavell Bigby-Williams' nine blocks against Grambling on Dec. 1 is tied for second most in a single game this season in the NCAA with the top two being in-state players:

After blocking five against Alabama, Bigby-Williams averages 2.2 blocks per game. That is T4 in the league and No. 32 in the nation.

KBW just missed becoming the third person in the last 30 years to have double figure blocks in a game. Shaquille O'Neal had games with 12 blocks (once), 11 (3 times) and 10 blocks (twice). Stromile Swift had 11 in a game once.

Since the start of the 2001-02 season, KBW joined the following LSU players who have had six or more blocks in a game are: Kavell Bigby-Williams (1), Tyrus Thomas (3), Chris Johnson (4), Jordan Mickey (4), Brandon Bass (2), Glen Davis (1), Anthony Randolph (1) and Malcolm White (1).

Bigby-Williams has also had some good games offensively this season:

Bigby-Williams 14-13 game against Alabama was his third double double of the season and in that game he was also 4-4 of the free throw line, upping his season percentage to 62.9% (22-35). However, in the last six games he is 15-of-20 at the line.

For the season, Bigby-Williams with five starts is averaging 7.3 points and 5.1 rebounds. He is averaging 17 minutes a game and is 40-of-59 from the field (67.8 percent).

DARIUS DAYS

The freshman has started three games for the Tigers and is averaging 7.1 points and 4.9 rebounds. He is 36-of-68 from the field and an impressive 18-of-22 at the free throw line.

In the three games as a starter, Days had 13 points and nine rebounds against Grambling (12/1), nine points and eight rebounds against Incarnate Word (12/9) and seven points and three boards at Houston (12/12). In the three games, Days was 11-of-21 from the floor with three treys.

His best game of the year came against Alabama (1/8) as far as scoring with 14 points on 5-of-10 shooting, including 3-of-4 from the arc.

In the last three games against Furman, ULM and Alabama, Days has scored 27 points and was 11-of-18 from the field and 4-of-6 from the arc with 14 rebounds.

NAZ REID

The freshman played his fewest minutes against Alabama (1/8) as he was saddled with foul trouble that limited him to 17 minutes before fouling out with seven points and three blocks.

Reid has done a lot of good things as he learned the methods of college basketball with four double figure games in the last six. He scored his first double double against ULM (12/28) with 19 points and 12 rebounds after just missing a double double against No. 24 Furman (12/21) when he had nine points and 10 rebounds.

In those six games discussed above, LSU is 5-1 with Reid 29-of-51 from the floor with three treys and 17-of-27 from the free throw line. The 19 against ULM was his second best scoring game of the year topped only by the 29 against UNCG in the second game of the season.

The freshman was named Player of the Week in Louisiana for his play in the ULM game by the Louisiana Sports Writers Association.

He is averaging for the year 12.2 points (third on the team) and 5.4 rebounds along with one assist and one block per game. He has started 12 games and is shooting 64-of-129 (49.6%) from the field with 12 treys.

EMMITT WILLIAMS

The freshman has been in double figures in two of the Tigers last four wins with 15 points versus Saint Mary's in the game in Las Vegas (12/15) and then 12 in 27 minutes off the bench against ULM (12/28).

That 15 points was a season high on 4-of-6 shooting and a perfect 7-of-7 at the free throw line. Williams had six boards with two assists and a steal. Against Furman (12/21), he hit all three field goal attempts and had eight points and against ULM he was 6-of-7 from the field with eight rebounds and two assists.

He has two double doubles – 12 points and 10 rebounds against Southeastern (11/6) and 11 points and 10 rebounds against Memphis (11/13).

Williams is averaging 8.8 points per game, 6.2 rebounds and is shooting 66.7 percent from the field (42-63) to go with 29-of-41 at the free throw line. Williams scoring is up 0.8 points in the last four games.

FRESHMAN SCORING WELL FOR TIGERS

Kenpom.com gives LSU an experience level at 14 games of 1.07, ranked 330 of the 353 teams as of the New Year. With Arkansas at 340, this will match two of the youngest teams in the Kenpom.com ranking. Only Kentucky at 350 is younger in the SEC then the two teams meeting tonight as far as experience is concerned.

The freshmen on the LSU team have scored 46.9 percent of LSU's points this season.

FORMER BASEBALL PLAYER SCORES IN BACK-TO-BACK GAMES

Former LSU baseball pitcher Will Reese scored his first two collegiate points in the Grambling game (12/1) and had another two against UIW (12/9). He joins a group of former players to have handled the two sport aspect at LSU. He was a scholarship pitcher for the baseball team for two seasons before deciding to walk-on to the men's basketball team at LSU, playing basketball for the first time since leading Anacoco High to two state titles.

He is the first two-sport player to score for LSU basketball since Robert Royal on Jan. 17, 20001 (FB, BKB) and he is the first LSU baseball player to record points since Lyle Mouton on March 17, 1989. Of course the SEC Network and ESPN/SEC Network's Ben McDonald also participated in both basketball and baseball in his time at LSU in the mid-1980s.

SERIES VERSUS ARKANSAS

The Razorbacks are 1-1 in the league after losing at home Wednesday night to Florida, 57-51. Mason Jones had a huge game for Arkansas with 30 points and three assists in 34 minutes. Jones was 7-of-13 from the floor with four treys and 12-of-13 at the free throw line as the only player in double figures. Daniel Gafford had nine points and 12 rebounds in the game. Arkansas shot just 30 percent from the floor (15-of-50) with six treys and 15 of 26 from the free throw line. Florida shot just 31 percent and both teams had 18 points in the paint.

For the season, Gafford is averaging 16.4 points a game, Isaiah Joe 14.8 and Jones 14.3 while Arkansas is averaging 79 points a game and giving up 69.4. In the two conference games, the Razorbacks averaged 62.0 points while giving up 64. The Razorbacks won their opening SEC game on the road, 73-71, at Texas A&M.

Arkansas leads the series, 35-30, but the Tigers have slowly closed the margin, winning 12-of-the-last-16 contests, including a 75-54 win here last year and 94-86 at the Maravich Center in the last Baton Rouge meeting. Arkansas has a 19-7 lead in games played in Fayetteville.

Mike Anderson is in his eighth season at Arkansas and has faced the Tigers both at Arkansas and during his tenure at UAB with a 6-9 record.

TIGERS GO ON THE ROAD AGAIN FOR TUESDAY

LSU will be back on the road Tuesday for an 8 p.m. game in Oxford against Ole Miss at The Pavilion before returning home on Saturday, Nov. 19 against South Carolina at 5 p.m. The Ole Miss game will be televised on the SEC Network and broadcast on the affiliates of the LSU Sports Radio Network.
