Tigers in the Rankings

- LSU is currently the No. 4 team in the country after it began the season ranked as the No. 7 team in the nation by both the AVCA and DiG Magazine
- On February 25, LSU cracked the Top-5 for the first time in the program's six year history, earning the No. 4 ranking in the AVCA and DiG polls
- The Tigers have been ranked in the Top-10 of the AVCA Poll for the past 27 weeks dating back to the April 25, 2016 poll
- LSU Finished as the No. 6 team in both polls following the 2018 season

Continued Success

- The Tigers have won 27 matches in each of the past two seasons and have eclipsed 20 wins in each of the past three seasons
- The past two seasons have been defined by win streaks of 24 in 2017 and 14 in 2018
- For the past two seasons, LSU has earned one of the final eight spots at the NCAA Championship in Gulf Shores, Alabama, winning one match at the event both years
- The Tigers became the first team from the East region to earn an at-large bid to the NCAA Championship in 2018
- On March 10, 2018, LSU defeated the University of Southern Cal, 4-1, becoming just the sixth program all-time to notch a victory over the Trojans

Beach Awards

- Claire Coppola and Kristen Nuss earned AVCA National Pair of the Week and CCSA Pair of the Week after going 4-0 during Week 1
- Four returners in Claire Coppola, Kristen Nuss, Megan Davenport and Maddie Ligon were awarded the AVCA Top-Flight Award in 2018 which goes to pairs who win 75-percent of their matches
- Hunter Domanski was named to the CCSA All-Freshmen Team after going 13-9 on Court 3 and compiling a seven-match win-streak
- Taryn Kloth was named to the Preseason CCSA Watch List

LSU Beach Volleyball Setting the Standard

- LSU opened the state-of-the-art LSU Beach Volleyball Stadium in the heart of LSU's campus in January
- The 24-inch deep sand courts have an underground irrigation and wetting system that will facilitate competition play during hot portions of the season, cooling the sand for comfortable play
- Energy efficient LED sand court lighting designed for TV level lighting

Head Coach Russell Brock (62-28)



Russell Brock is entering his third season as the full time head coach at LSU after spending his first three seasons as the associate head coach under Fran Flory from the programs conception in 2014.

With Brock at the helm, the Tigers have cemented themselves as one of the top beach volleyball programs in the nation. In his first two seasons, Brock has led LSU to 54 victories, 27 each year, and the Tigers have been one of the final six teams at the NCAA Championship both years. In 2017 and 2018 Brock has helped lead LSU to national prominence, maintaining a top-10 ranking in the AVCA poll over the entirety of his tenure thus far and picking up win streaks of 23 and 14 along the way. In his first year leading the Tigers, Brock was named the CCSA Coach of the Year after taking LSU to its first NCAA Championship appearance. Since being named the head coach prior the 2017 season, Brock has led the Tigers to an impressive 54-22 record.

Coach Brock saw the process through of moving the Tigers to their new on-campus home at LSU Beach Volleyball Stadium in 2018.

Brock has helped coach four players to the CCSA All-Freshmen team, including the Co-CCSA Freshman of the Year, Lilly Kessler, during his final season as the associate head coach. In his first season as the official head coach, Brock led the Tigers to their first appearance at the NCAA Championship, taking home Coach of the Year honors. He has coached two All-Americans, both coming from Court 1 and playing as partners, Claire Coppola and Kristen Nuss. Brock coached the Tigers' top duo to the CCSA Pair of the Year in 2018. Coppola and Nuss followed that up with a win at the USAV Collegiate Beach Championships in May of 2018, earning a spot in the FISU World University Games later that year.

Prior to joining LSU, Brock spent eight seasons with the indoor volleyball program at Rice University. He served as a volunteer coach from 2006 to 2008 before being promoted to assistant coach in 2009. The Owls totaled 141 wins, two NCAA tournament trips and the program's first Conference USA championship in 2009. Brock helped in the development of middle blockers. He coached Natalie Bogan and Nancy Cole to AVCA All-American honors, and coached four of the top seven players on Rice's all-time total blocks list.

Before joining the coaching staff at Rice, Brock spent 11 years at Baytown Christian Academy in Texas as the school's athletic director and operations manager. He coached the girls' volleyball team and won four Texas Association of Private and Parochial Schools state titles. Brock was also a standout athlete at the University of Southern California, leading the program's all-time record in digs tallying 956, a record he held for 10 years. He also set an NCAA record with 45 matches with 10-plus digs. Brock graduated from USC in 1996 with a B.S. in exercise science.

He and his wife, Kristi, have two daughters, Brooklynn, Kaelynn, and one son, Kory.

The Tigers have been featured in the AVCA Top-10 for 27 consecutive weeks dating back to April 25, 2016. Since then, LSU has been as low as No. 10 and as high as No. 4. For two consecutive seasons, the Tigers have won 27 matches and finished as the No. 6 team in both the AVCA and DiG poll, making an appearance at the NCAA Championship in Gulf Shores as one of the final eight teams in the country.

The Tigers are 7-4 this season against AVCA Top-20 teams and have amassed five wins over AVCA Top-10 opponents.
